I pair of 3.25mm (UK10-US4) and I pair 4mm (UK8-US6) Knitting needles. Stitch Holders

Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm, 4ins over st st on 4mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm,

your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

K - Knit; P - Purl; st(s) - stitch(es);
g st - garter stitch (every row

BACK

** Using 3.25mm needles and M, cast on 75 (87, 99, 111, 123, 135, 147) sts.

Work 14 rows g st.

Change to 4mm needles, continue in st st starting with a K row until Back measures 19 (26.5, 33, 38, 38, 38, 38)cm, 7.5 (10.5, 13, 15, 15, 15)ins, at centre from commencement, ending with a K row.

Knit 3 rows.

Place Chart (on back page)

For 51/56, 61/66, 71/76 and 81/86cm (20/22, 24/26, 28/30 and 32/34ins) Sizes Only

Starting with a knit row commence the chart on the 7th row and finish on the 31st row (25 rows).

For 91/97, 102/107 and 112/117cm (36/38, 40/42 and 44/46ins) Sizes Only

Starting with a knit row commence the chart on the 1st row and finish on the 37th row (37 rows).

All Sizes Continue in M only.

Purl one row. Knit 4 rows.**

Starting with a knit row continue in st st until Back measures 38 (48, 58, 66, 69, 70, 71)cm, 15 (19, 23, 26, 27, 27.5, 28)ins, at centre from commencement, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 5 (6, 4, 5, 7, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 7 (8, 5, 5, 6, 7, 7) sts at beg of following 2 (2, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows, then 6 (7, 6, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of next 4 (4, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) rows. Leave rem 27 (31, 35, 39, 43, 47, 51)

sts on a st holder.

FRONT

Work as for Back from **to **
Starting with a knit row work
straight in st st until Front
measures 34.5 (43, 52, 58.5, 61, 62,
63.5)cm, 13.5 (17, 20.5, 23, 24, 24.5,
25)ins, at centre from
commencement, ending with a
wrong side row.

Divide for Neck

Next row (rs) - K30 (36, 41, 46, 50, 54, 58), turn and leave rem sts on a st holder. Continue on these 30 (36, 41, 46, 50, 54, 58) sts for first side, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 27 (31, 35, 39, 43, 47, 51) sts rem.

Continue straight until Front matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending at side edge.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 6 (7, 5, 6, 8, 7, 8) sts at beg of next row, 7 (8, 6, 6, 7, 8, 8) sts at beg of following I (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) alt rows, then 7 (8, 6, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of following 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3) alt rows.

With right side facing, slip centre 15 (15, 17, 19, 23, 27, 31) sts onto a st holder, rejoin yarn to rem 30 (36, 41, 46, 50, 54, 58) sts, patt to end. Finish to correspond with first side.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 3.25mm needles and M, cast on 49 (55, 59, 63, 69, 73, 76) sts.
Work 14 rows in g st.
Change to 4mm needles.

Place Chart (on back page)

Starting with a knit row work all 23 rows of chart, shaping sides as indicated on chart by inc I st at each end of 5th (Ist, 3rd, IIth, 3rd, Ist, Ist) and every following 4 (5, 5, 4, 4, 5, 5)th row.
Continue in M only.

Purl one row.

Knit 4 rows, keeping shaping correct.

Starting with a K row work in st st, continuing to shape the sides by inc I st at each end of every 4 (5, 5, 4, 4, 5, 5)th row until there are 71 (83, 93, 105, 114, 119, 122) sts. Work straight until sleeve seam measures 24 (31.5, 39, 45.5, 45.5, 51, 51)cm, 9.5 (12.5, 15.5, 18, 18, 20, 20)ins, ending with a P row. Cast off loosely knitwise.

NECK BORDER

Join right shoulder seam. With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles and M, pick up and K19 (21, 22, 25, 25, 25, 25) sts down left side of neck, K15 (15, 17, 19, 23, 27, 31) from centre, pick up and K19 (21, 22, 25, 25, 25, 25) up right side, then K27 (31, 35, 39, 43, 47, 51) from Back, inc 2 sts evenly across. 82 (90, 98, 110, 118, 126, 134) sts.

Ist row - P2, * K2, P2, rept from * to end.


2nd row (rs) - K2,* P2, K2, rept from * to end.


Rept these 2 rows 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4) times more.

Knit 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 6) rows. Cast off loosely.

MAKING UP

Join left shoulder seam. Place markers on the row end edges of the Back and Front 16 (19, 21, 24, 26, 27, 28) cm, 6.25 (7.5, 8.25, 9.5, 10.25, 10.5, 11) ins, below shoulder seam. Pin cast off edge of sleeves between markers on Back and Front, sew in position, then join side and sleeve seams.





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
