Instructions given for 31 cm (12 inch) Chest, larger sizes given in round brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**ch** – chain; **htr** – half treble;

ss – slip stitch; dc – double crochet; htr2tog – \* yarn round hook and insert hook into st, yarn round hook and draw loop through, rept from \* once more, yarn round hook and draw through all 5 loops on hook;

st(s) - stitches; rept - repeat;
beg - beginning; dec - decrease;
patt - pattern; 0 - no sts, rows or
times to be worked in that
particular size; cm - centimetres;
ins - inches.

#### **TENSION**

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 18 sts and 13 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) over half treble fabric on 3.5mm hook.

If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, your tension is tight and you will need to change your hook to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm, your tension is

loose and you will need to change your hook to a smaller size.

#### JACKET BACK

Using 3.5mm hook, make 34 (39, 44, 49, 54, 59) ch.

Foundation row (right side) - I htr into 3rd ch from hook, I htr into each ch to end, turn. 33 (38, 43, 48, 53, 58) sts.

#### **Commence patt**

Ist row - 2 ch (counts as first htr)
I htr into each st to end, working last htr into top of 2 ch at beg of previous row, turn.
This row forms patt.

Work a further 12 (12, 14, 18, 22, 26) rows in patt, thus finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Shape armholes

Next row - Ss across and into 3rd (3rd, 4th, 4th, 5th, 5th) st, 2 ch (counts as first htr), htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into each st to last 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) sts, htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into next st, turn, leaving remaining 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4) sts unworked. 27 (32, 35, 40, 43, 48) sts.

Next row - 2 ch (counts as first htr) htr2tog, over next 2 sts, I htr into each st to last 3 sts, htr2tog, over next 2 sts, I htr into last st, turn.

Rept last row 1 (2, 2, 3, 3, 4) times more. 23 (26, 29, 32, 35, 38) sts. Work 6 (7, 9, 10, 10, 11) rows without shaping, thus finishing on a right side row.

Fasten off.

Place markers either side of centre II (12, 15, 16, 19, 20) sts to denote back neck.

#### **LEFT FRONT**

Using 3.5mm hook, make 21 (24, 26, 29, 31, 34) ch.
Work foundation row as given for

back. 20 (23, 25, 28, 30, 33) sts.

#### Girl's version only

Work 13 (13, 15, 19, 23, 27) rows in patt as given for back, thus finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Boy's version only

Work 4 (6, 6, 10, 10, 12) rows in patt as given for back, thus finishing on a right side row.

#### **Buttonhole row (wrong side)**

- 2 ch (counts as first htr), I htr into each of next 2 sts, 2 ch, miss 2 sts (to make a buttonhole – on next row work 2 htr into this ch space), I htr into each st to end, turn.

Patt 5 (5, 7, 7, 9, 11) rows. Rept the buttonhole row again. Patt 2 (0, 0, 0, 2, 2) rows, thus finishing on a wrong side row.

#### **BOTH VERSIONS**

#### Shape armholes

Next row - Ss across and into 3rd (3rd, 4th, 4th, 5th, 5th) st, 2 ch (counts as first htr), htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into each st to end, turn. 17 (20, 21, 24, 25, 28) sts. Working armhole decreases as given for back, dec I st at armhole edge on next 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) rows. 15 (17, 18, 20, 21, 23) sts.

#### Girl's version only

Patt 2 (3, 5, 4, 4, 5) rows, thus finishing on a right side row.

#### Boy's version only

Patt 0 (1, 3, 2, 2, 3) rows. Rept the buttonhole row once more. Patt 1 row, thus finishing on a right side row.

#### **BOTH VERSIONS**

#### Shape neck

Next row (wrong side) - Ss across and into 6 (7, 8, 7, 8, 9)th st, 2 ch,(counts as first htr), htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into each st to end, turn. 9 (10, 10, 13, 13, 14) sts.

Working decreases as for armhole, dec I st at neck edge on next 3 (3, 3, 5, 5, 5) rows. Fasten off.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

Using 3.5mm hook, make 21 (24, 26, 29, 31, 34) ch.
Work foundation row as given for back. 20 (23, 25, 28, 30, 33) sts.

#### Boy's version only

Work 13 (13, 15, 19, 23, 27) rows in patt as given for back, thus finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Girl's version only

Work 4 (6, 6, 10, 10, 12) rows in patt as given for back, thus finishing on a right side row.

Buttonhole row (wrong side) - 2 ch (counts as first htr), I htr into each st to last 5 sts, 2 ch, miss 2 sts (to make a buttonhole — on next row work 2 htr into this ch space), I htr into each of last 3 sts, turn. Patt 5 (5, 7, 7, 9, 11) rows. Rept the buttonhole row again. Patt 2 (0, 0, 0, 2, 2) rows, thus finishing on a wrong side row.

#### **BOTH VERSIONS**

#### Shape armholes

Next row - 2 ch (counts as first htr), I htr into each st to last 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) sts, htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into next st, turn, leaving remaining 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4) sts unworked. 17 (20, 21, 24, 25, 28) sts. Working armhole decreases as given for back, dec I st at armhole edge on next 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) rows. 15 (17, 18, 20, 21, 23) sts.

#### Boy's version only

Patt 2 (3, 5, 4, 4, 5) rows, thus finishing on a right side row.

#### Girl's version only

Patt 0 (1, 3, 2, 2, 3) rows. Rept the buttonhole row once more. Patt 1 row, thus finishing on a right side row.

#### **BOTH VERSIONS**

#### Shape neck

Next row (wrong side) - 2 ch (counts as first htr), I htr into each st to last 8 (9, 10, 9, 10, 11) sts, htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into next st, turn, leaving remaining 5 (6, 7, 6, 7, 8) sts unworked. 9 (10, 10, 13, 13, 14) sts. Working decreases as for armhole, dec I st at neck edge on next 3 (3, 3, 5, 5, 5) rows. Fasten off.

#### **SLEEVES** (both alike)

Using 3.5mm hook, make 19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 29) ch.

Work foundation row as given for back. 18 (20, 22, 24, 26, 28) sts. Work 7 rows in patt as given for back, thus finishing on a wrong side row.

Next row - 2 ch (counts as first htr), 2 htr into next st, I htr into each st to last 2 sts, 2 htr into next st, I htr into last st, turn. Patt I row.

Rept last 2 rows 3 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8) times more. 26 (30, 34, 38, 42, 46) sts. Patt a further 0 (0, 0, 2, 4, 8) rows.

#### Shape top

Next row - Ss across and into 3rd (3rd, 4th, 4th, 5th, 5th) st, 2 ch (counts as first htr), htr2tog, over next 2 sts, I htr into each st to last 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) sts, htr2tog, over next 2 sts, I htr into next st, turn, leaving remaining 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4) sts unworked. 20 (24, 26, 30, 32, 36) sts.

Next row - 2 ch (counts as first htr), htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into each st to last 3 sts, htr2tog over next 2 sts, I htr into last st, turn.

Rept last row 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10) times more. 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 14) sts. Fasten off.

#### **MAKING UP**

Join shoulder seams by top sewing.

#### Collar

Using 3.5mm hook, make 36 (39, 46, 53, 60, 63) ch.

Work foundation row as given for back. 35 (38, 45, 52, 59, 62) sts. Work 4 rows in patt as given for back. Fasten off.

Sew collar to neck edge, easing collar to fit and positioning row ends of collar 4 sts in from front opening edges.

Join side seams by top sewing. Join sleeve seams by top sewing, reversing seam for first 5 rows for turn back. Insert sleeves.

#### **EDGING**

With right side facing and using 3mm hook, work I round of dc evenly around entire outer edge of jacket, ending round with ss to first dc. Fasten off.
Work edging around cuff edge of sleeves in same way, and then fold first 4 rows to right side at lower edge for turn-back. Sew on buttons.

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
