## ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; P - Purl; sts - stitches; st st - stocking stitch (I row knit, I row purl); tog - together; beg - beginning; rept - repeat; inc - increase, dec - decrease; sl-slip; sl I - slip one; psso - pass slipped stitch over; patt - pattern; M - main; A Ist contrast; B - 2nd contrast; cm - centimetres; ins - inches; MDS Make Double Stitch.

## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 14 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm ,

4ins over st st on 6.5 mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.
Note:- Strand yarn loosely across back of work over no more than 4 stitches keeping fabric elastic.

## NECK WARMER

Using 6.5 mm circular needle and M, cast on $180(192,204,216)$ sts. Mark last st with a coloured thread to denote start of round.

## Commence Rib

Ist round - *KI, PI, rept from * to end.
This row sets the rib. Continue in rib for 6.5 (6.5, 7.5, 7.5)cm, 2.5 (2.5, 3,3 )ins

## Commence Fair Isle Patt

Join in A and B.Work in rounds, every round knit.
Ist round - *IA, IM, IA, IB, rept from * to end.
2nd round - *3A, IB, rept from *
to end.
3rd, 4th and 5th rounds - *IB, IA, IB, IM, rept from * to end.
6th round - Using $B$, knit.
7th round (dec round) - Using $B$, *K4, sl I, K2tog, psso, K5, rept from * to end. I50 (I60, I70, I80) sts. 8th round - $* 2 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{I}, 2 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{~B}$, $I M$, rept from * to end.
9th round - $* \mid B, 2 A, 3 M, 2 A, 2 B$, rept from * to end.
10 th round $-* 2 A, 2 M, I B, 2 M, 2 A$, $I B$, rept from * to end.
IIth round - *IA, 2M, 3B, 2M, 2A, rept from * to end.
12 th round $-* 2 \mathrm{M}, 2 \mathrm{~B}, \mathrm{I} \mathrm{A}, 2 \mathrm{~B}$,
$2 \mathrm{M}, \mathrm{IA}$, rept from * to end.
13 th round $-* \mid M, 2 B, 3 A, 2 B, 2 M$, rept from * to end.
14 th round $-* 2 B, 5 A, 2 B$, IM, rept from * to end.
I5th round (dec round) - *IB, IM, IA, sI I, K2tog A, psso, IA, IM, IB, IA, rept from * to end. I20 (I28, 136, I44) sts.
16 th round $-* I A, 2 M, I A, 2 M, 2 A$, rept from * to end.
I7th round $-* 2 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{M}, 2 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{IB}$, rept from * to end.
I8th round $-* I B, 2 A, I M, 2 A, I B$, $I M$, rept from * to end.
19 th round -As 17 th round.
20th round $-* I A, 2 M, I B, 2 M, 2 A$, rept from * to end.
2 Ist round - *IB, IM, $3 B, I M, I B$, $I A$, rept from * to end.
22nd round - *7B, IM, rept from * to end.

23rd round (dec round) - *IM, IB, sl I, K2tog B, psso, IB, IM, IA, rept from * to end. $90(96, I 02, I 08)$ sts.
24th round - *2M, IB, 2M, IA, rept from * to end.
25th round - *IA, 3M, 2A, rept from * to end.
26th round - $* 2 A$, IM, $2 A$, IB, rept from * to end.
27th round - *IB, $3 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{~B}$, rept from * to end.
28th round - $* 2 B$, $I A, 2 B$, $I M$, rept from * to end.
29th round $-* I M, I B, I A, I B, 2 M$, rept from * to end.
30th round $-* 5 \mathrm{M}, \mathrm{IA}$, rept from

* to end.

Break off $A$ and $B$.
Continue in M only.
3 Ist round (dec round) - *sI I, KI,
psso, KI, K2tog, KI, rept from * to end. $60(64,68,72)$ sts.
(91/97, I02/I 07, I | $2 /| | 7$ )cm, (36/38, 40/42, 44/46)ins Sizes Only
Next round (dec round) - K(7, 3, 3), K2tog, * K(I4, IO, 7) K2tog, rept from * to last $(7,3,4)$ sts, K to end. $(60,62,64)$ sts.

## ALL SIZES

## Shape Back Neck

Work in German short rows.
Next row - KI5 (15, I6, I7) sts, turn.
Next row - MDS, P30 (30, 32, 34)
sts, turn.
Next row - MDS, K24 $(24,26,28)$
sts, turn.
Next row - MDS, PI8 (I8, 20, 22)
sts, turn.
Next round - Knit across all sts resolving double stitches as you come to them.
Change to 8 mm circular needle.
Work $20(20,23.5,23.5) \mathrm{cm}, 8$ ( 8,9 ,
9)ins in KI, PI, rib.

Cast off loosely in rib.
