Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

## ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; P - Purl; st(s) - stitch(es); st st - stocking stitch; inc - increase; dec - decrease; beg - beginning; alt - alternate; tog together; rept - repeat; sl - slip; tbl - through back of loop; cm - centimetres; ins - inches; $\mathbf{M}$ - main.

## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 22sts and 3I rows to 10 cm (4ins) over st st using 4 mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

## When working from a

 colourwork chart yarn can be stranded at the back of the work. Do not strand across more than 4 stitches, in this case the yarn must be woven in.
## BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles and M , cast on 98 (I02, IIO, IIO, I22, I22, I34, I34) sts.
I st row (right side) - K2, * P2, K2, rept from * to end.
2nd row - P2, * K2, P2, rept from

* to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 10 rows, inc (dec, inc, inc, inc, inc, inc, inc) I st at end of last row and finishing on a wrong side row. 99 (IOI, I I I, I II, I23, I23, I35, I 35 ) sts.
Change to 4 mm needles.
Starting with a K row, now work in st st throughout as follows:- ** Work straight until Back measures $3 \mathrm{I}(40,4 \mathrm{I}, 4 \mathrm{I}, 42,42,43,43) \mathrm{cm}$, 12.25 (I5.75, 16, I6, 16.5, I6.5, I7, 17)ins, from cast on edge, finishing on a wrong side row.

## Shape Armholes

Cast off $3(4,4,4,4,4,4,4)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows. 93 (93, I03, 103, II5, II5, I27, I27) sts.
Dec I st at each end of next and foll $4(6,6,6,6,6,6,6)$ alt rows. 83 ( $79,89,89,10|,|0|,|I 3, I| 3)$ sts. *** Continue straight until armhole measures 18 (20, 2 I, 2I, 22, 22, 23, 23)cm, 7 (7.75, $8.258 .25,8.25,8.25$, $9,9)$ ins, finishing on a wrong side row.

## Shape Shoulders and Back Neck

Cast off 8 (7, 9, 9, I0, I0, I2, I2) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 67 (65, 7I, 7I, 8I, 8I, 89, 89) sts.
Next row (right side) - Cast off $8(7,9,9,10,10,12,12)$ sts, $K$ until there are $10(I I, I I, I I, I 4, I 4, I 4$, 14) sts on right needle and turn, leaving remaining sts on a holder. Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.
Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. Cast off remaining $7(8,8,8, I I, I I$, II, I I) sts. Return to sts left on holder, rejoin yarn with right side facing, cast off centre 31 ( 29,3 I, $31,33,33,37,37)$ sts, $K$ to end.
Cast off $8(7,9,9,10,10,12,12)$
sts at beg of next row, then 3 sts at beg of foll row, $K$ to end.
Cast off remaining $7(8,8,8, I I$, II, II, II) sts.

## FRONT

Work as given for Back to **.

## Place Fairisle Border

Work from the chart between the markers indicated for your size.
Keeping Chart correct work as given for Back from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$. Work straight until I8 (22, 22, 22, $24,24,26,26$ ) rows less have been worked than on back to start of shoulder shaping, finishing on a wrong side row.

## Shape Front Neck

Next row (right side) - K33 (33, $37,37,43,43,48,48)$ and turn, leaving remaining sts on a holder. Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.
Dec I st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll $4(4,4,4,5,5,6$, 6) alt rows.

Dec I st at neck edge on foll 4th row. 23 (22, 26, 26, 3I, 3I, 35, 35) sts.

## All Sizes

Work 3 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.
Shape Shoulder

Cast off $8(7,9,9,10,10,12,12)$ sts at beg of next and foll alt row.
Work I row.
Cast off remaining $7(8,8,8, I I, I I$, I I, I I) sts. Return to sts left on holder, rejoin yarn with right side facing, cast off centre $17(13,15,15$, $15,15,17,17)$ sts, $K$ to end.
Dec I st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll $4(4,4,4,5,5,6$, 6) alt rows.
(8I, 86, 9I, 97, I02, I07, II2)cm,
(32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44)ins sizes only
Dec I st at neck edge on foll 4th row. 23 (22, 26, 26, 3I, 3I, 35, 35) sts.

## All Sizes

Work 3 rows, finishing on a right side row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off $8(7,9,9,10,10,12,12)$ sts at beg of next and foll alt row.
Work I row.
Cast off remaining 7 ( $8,8,8, \mathrm{II}, \mathrm{II}$, II, II) sts.

## SLEEVES (both alike)

Using 3.25 mm needles and $M$ cast on $50(50,50,50,54,54,58,58)$ sts.
Starting with Ist row, work in rib as given for back for 12 rows, dec (dec, inc, inc, dec, dec) I st at end of last row and finishing on a wrong side row. 49 ( $49,5 \mathrm{I}, 5 \mathrm{I}, 55$, $55,57,57)$ sts.
Change to 4 mm needles. Starting with a K row, continuing in st st throughout, work from the chart for the sleeve starting between the markers indicated for your size and taking inc sts into chart, Inc I st at each end of 3rd and every foll 4th row to 55 (57, $63,63,63,63,65,65)$ sts, then on every foll 6th row until there are 87 ( $89,93,93,97,97,101,101$ ) sts. Continue straight until sleeve measures 42 ( $46,47,47,48,48,50$, $50) \mathrm{cm}, 16.5$ ( $18,18.5,18.5,19,19$, 19.5, 19.5)ins, finishing on a wrong side row.

## Shape Top

Cast off $3(4,4,4,4,4,4,4)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows. 8 I ( $8 \mathrm{I}, 85,85$,
$89,89,93,93)$ sts.
Dec I st at each end of next and foll $3(5,5,5,5,5,5,5)$ alt rows, then on foll row, finishing on a wrong side row.
Cast off remaining 7I (67,7I, 7I, $75,75,79,79)$ sts.

## MAKING UP

Join right shoulder seam by top sewing.

## Neckband

With right side facing, using 3.25 mm needles and $M$, pick up and knit 19 (2I, 2I, 2I, 24, 24, 25, 25) sts down left side of neck, 17 $(13,15,15,15,15,17,17)$ sts from front, 19 (2I, 2I, 2I, 24, 24, 25, 25) sts up right side of neck, and 38 $(35,37,37,39,39,43,43)$ sts from back. 93 (90, 94, 94, I02, I02, IIO, IIO) sts.
Starting with 2nd row, work in rib as given for back for 7 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.
Next row (right side) - Knit. Cast off knitwise (on wrong side). Join left shoulder and Neckband seam by top sewing. Join side seams by top sewing. Insert sleeves into armholes, join sleeve seams.

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
