### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**K** - knit; **P** - purl; **st(s)** - stitch(es); psso - pass slipped stitch over; st st - stocking stitch (one row knit, one row purl); rept - repeat; **Kfb** - knit into front and back of next st; sl - slip; MI - make one stitch by picking up the loop between stitches and knitting into the back of this loop; yfwd - yarn forward; tog - together; cm - centimetres: ins - inches:

### **TENSION**

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. Tension 24 sts and 32 rows to 10cm 4ins over st st on 4mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm,

then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

### **COMMENCE PATTERN**

Using 3.25mm needles and A cast on 73 (79, 85, 91, 97) sts.

**Ist row** - KI,\* PI, KI, rept from \*

2nd row - PI, \* KI, PI, rept from

These two rows form rib, rept 1st and 2nd rows three times more. Change to 4mm needles, and st st, commencing with a K row.

# 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only

Using B, work (2, 4, 6) rows.

# All sizes

### **Commence chart**

**1st row** - Using B, K18 (21, 24, 27, 30), work across all 37 sts of 1st row of chart, joining in contrast where shown, and starting a 2nd length of B for 2nd block of colour, using B, K 18 (21, 24, 27, 30). 2nd row - Using B, P18 (21, 24, 27, 30) work across 2nd row of chart, using B, P18 (21, 24, 27, 30). Continue working in st st as set, working all side stitches in B and following all 22 rows of chart.

### **SHAPE TOP**

2nd size only

Next row - KI, \* KII, K2tog, reptfrom \* to end. 73 sts.

Next row - P.

### 3rd size only

Next row - KI, \* K26, K2tog, rept from \* to end. 82 sts.

Next row - P.

### 5th size only

Next row - KI, \* KI4, K2tog, rept from \* to end. 91 sts.

Next row - P.

### All sizes

**Ist row** - K1,\* K2tog, K6 (6, 7, 8, 8), rept from \* to end. 64 (64, 73, 82, 82) sts.

2nd row - P.

3rd row - K.

4th row - P.

5th row - KI, \* K2tog, K5 (5, 6, 7, 7) rept from \* to end. 55 (55, 64, 73, 73) sts.

6th row - P.

7th row - K.

8th row - P.

9th row - K1, \* K2tog, K4 (4, 5, 6, 6), rept from \* to end. 46 (46, 55, 64, 64) sts.

10th row - P.

11th row - K1, \* K2tog, K3 (3, 4, 5, 5), rept from \* to end. 37 (37, 46, 55, 55) sts.

12th row - P.

**13th row** - K1, \* K2tog, K2 (2, 3, 4, 4), rept from \* to end. 28 (28, 37, 46, 46) sts.

14th row - P.

**15th row** - KI, \* K2tog, KI (1, 2, 3, 3) rept from \* to end. 19 (19, 28, 37, 37) sts.

### 1st and 2nd sizes only

**16th row** - \* P2tog, rept from \* to last st, PI. 10 sts. Break yarn and thread through remaining 10 sts and fasten off.

### 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes

16th row - P.

**17th row** - KI, \* K2tog, K (I, 2, 2), rept from \* to end. (19, 28, 28) sts

### 3rd size only

**18th row** - \* P2 tog, rept from \* to last st, PI. 10 sts.

Break yarn and thread through remaining 10 sts and fasten off.

<sup>3.25</sup>mm (US3) 4mm (US6) Knitting Needles.

<sup>2</sup> Buttons

4th and 5th sizes only 18th row - P 19th row - KI,\* K2tog, KI, rept from \* to end. 19sts. 20th row - \* P2 tog, rept from \* to last st, PI. 10 sts. Break yarn and thread through remaining 10 sts and fasten off.

## **MAKING UP**

Join back seam by top sewing. Stitch eyes on as shown in photograph.
