Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

## ABBREVIATIONS

A - Ist contrast; alt - alternate; B 2nd contrast, C-3rd contrast; cm - centimetres; cont - continue; dec - decrease; g st - garter stitch (every row K); inc - increase; ins inches; K - knit; rept - repeat; tog - together; tbl - through back of loops; st(s) - stitch(es).

## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 20 sts and 40 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{ins}$ over garter stitch on 4.5 mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is tight and you will
need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

## COMMENCE PATTERN

Using 4.5 mm needles and A , cast on I st.
I st row - Inc into this st. 2 sts.
2nd row - Inc into first st, KI. 3 sts.
3rd row - Inc into first st, K to end.
Rept 3rd row only until there are 80 sts.
Break off $A$, join in $B$.

## First Pattern Block

Ist row - Inc into first st, K2tog tbl, turn.
2nd and every alt row - Knit.
3rd row - Inc into first st, KI, K2tog tbl, turn.
5th row - Inc into first st, K2, K2tog tbl, turn.
7th row - Inc into first st, K3, K2tog tbl, turn.
Cont inc every alt row (as set)
until the following row has been worked:Inc into first st, K77, K2tog tbl, turn.
This completes the Pattern Block.
Work I more pattern block in B.

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Break off B, join in C.
Work 2 pattern blocks in $C$ then 2 pattern blocks in A.

## End Section

Using B work Pattern Block until the following row has been worked:-
Inc into first st, K37, K2tog tbl, turn.
Next row - K38, K2tog, turn.
Next row - K38, K2tog tbl, turn.
Next row - K37, K2tog, turn.
Next row - K37, K2tog tbl, turn.
Next row - K36, K2tog, turn.
Next row - K36, K2tog tbl, turn.
Cont to dec as set until I st remains.
Fasten off.

## Optional Fringe/Tassels

These can be made using any remaining yarn.
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
