## ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; st(s) - stitch(es); beg

- beginning; alt - alternate; patt pattern; rept - repeat; inc - increase; rem - remain(ing); tog - together; cm - centimetres; ins - inches; Kw2 - KI winding yarn twice round needle; yfwd yarnforward ; CI3 (5) Cluster 3(5) by slipping next 3(5) sts.
dropping extra loops off needle, insert left needle back into these 3(5) long sts and P3(5)tog; sl - slip.


## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 18 sts and 21 rows to 10 cm . (4 ins) over patt on 5 mm Needles.
If there are too many stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.
NOTE: When counting sts. or casting off, the extra sts made on Rows I and 5 are not included.

## BACK

** Using 5 mm Needles, cast on 87 (99, I05, III) sts and KI row.

## Commence Patt.

I st Row (Right Side) - KI, (KI, yfwd, KI) in next st, * [Kw2] 5 times, (KI, yfwd, KI, yfwd, KI) in next st; rept from * to last 7 sts [Kw2] 5 times, (KI, yfwd, KI) in next st, KI
2nd Row - K4,* Cl5, K5;
rept from * to last $9 \mathrm{sts}, \mathrm{CI5}, \mathrm{~K} .4$.
3rd and 4th Rows - K
5th Row - KI, [Kw2] 3 times,*
(KI, yfwd, KI, yfwd, KI) in next st, [Kw2] 5 times; rept from * to last 5
sts, (KI, yfwd, KI, yfwd.,
KI ) in next st, [Kw2] 3 times, KI .
6th Row - KI, CI3, * K5,
$\mathrm{CI5}$; rept from * to last 9 sts,
K5, CI3, KI.
7th and 8th Rows - K.
These 8 rows form patt.
Work straight in patt until
Back measures 44.5 cm ( 17.25 ins) at centre from start, ending with a wrong side row. Place a marker at each end of last row.** Continue in patt. until Back measures 67 ( $69,70,7 \mathrm{I}$ ) cm, $26 \mathrm{I} / 2(27,27.5,28)$ ins at centre from start, ending with a wrong side row.

## Shape Shoulders

Cast off $6(7,7,9)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows, $6(7,7,8)$ sts at beg of following 2 rows, then $6(8,8,8)$ sts at beg of next 4 rows. Leave rem $39(39,45,45)$ sts on a st holder.

## FRONT

Work as given for Back from ** to**.
Continue in patt until Front measures 62 ( $63.5,64.5,66$ ) cm., $24.25(25,25.25,26)$ ins. at centre from start, ending with 2nd or 6th patt row.

## Divide for Neck

Next Row - K36 (42, 42, 45),
turn and leave rem. sts. on a spare needle.
Continue on these $36(42,42$, 45) sts for first side, shaping neck by casting off 3 sts at beg of next and following 3 alt rows. $24(30,30,33)$ sts.
Continue straight in patt until Front matches Back to start of
shoulder shaping, ending at side edge

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off $6(7,7,9)$ sts at beg of next row, $6(7,7,8)$ sts at beg of following alt row, then $6(8,8,8)$ sts at beg of following 2 alt rows. With right side facing sl centre 15 (I5,2I, 2I) sts onto a st holder, rejoin yarn to rem $36(42,42,45)$ sts, $K$ to end. Finish to correspond with first side.

## SHORT SLEEVES

(Both alike)
With 5 mm Needles, cast on $57(57,63,63)$ sts and KI row.
Starting with Ist Row, work in patt as for Back, shaping sides by inc I st at each end of $3 r d$ (Ist, 3rd, 7th) and every following 3rd (3rd, 3rd 2nd) row until there are $77(81,85,89)$ sts, taking inc sts. into patt. Continue straight until Sleeve seam measures 17 cm (6.25ins), ending with a wrong side row. Cast off loosely knitways

## NECK BORDER

Join the right shoulder seam by top sewing.
With right side facing and using 3.75 mm needles, pick up and knit 19 sts down left side of neck. KI5 (I5, 2I, 2I) from centre, pick up and $K 19$ sts up right side, then K. $39(39,45,45)$ from Back. 92 (92, I04, I04) sts.
K 4 rows
Cast off loosely knitways.

## MAKING UP

Join left shoulder seam by top sewing. Pin cast-off edge of sleeve between markers on Back and Front, sew in position, then join side and underarm sleeve seams by top sewing, leaving 17.5 cm (7 ins) open at lower edge for side vents.
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
