## ABBREVIATIONS

C4B - slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle;
Cr3L - slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, PI, then K2 from cable needle; Cr3R - slip next st onto cable needle. and leave at back of work,

K 2 , then PI from cable needle;
Tw2 - K2tog leaving both sts on left needle, $K$ first of these 2 sts again and slip both sts off left needle at same time;
alt - alternate; beg - beginning;-
cont - continue; dec - decreas(e) (ing); foll - following; in - inch(es); inc - increas(e)(ing); K - knit; mm - millimetres; $\mathbf{P}$ - purl; patt pattern; psso - pass slipped st over; rem - remain(ing); rep - repeat; rs - right side; sl I - slip one stitch; st(s) - stitch(es); tbl - through back of loops; tog - together; ws wrong side

## TENSION

20 stitches and 24 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over fancy rib pattern when slightly stretched using 4.5 mm needles. Cable panel (24 sts) measures II cm.

## CABLE PANEL

Row I: (rs) PIO, C4B, PIO.
Row 2: KIO, P4, KIO.

Row 3: P9, Cr3R, Cr3L, P9.
Row 4: K9, P6, K9.
Row 5: P8, Cr3R, P2, Cr3L, P8.
Row 6: K8, P8, K8.
Row 7: P7, Cr3R, P4, Cr3L, P7.
Row 8: K7, PIO, K7.
Row 9: P6, Cr3R, P6, Cr3L, P6.
Row I0: K6, PI2, K6.
Row II: P5, Cr3R, P8, Cr3L, P5.
Row 12: K5, PI4, K5.
Row 13: P4, Cr3R, PIO, Cr3L, P4.
Row 14: K4, PI6, K4.
Row I5: P4, Cr3L, PIO, Cr3R, P4.
Row 16: as row 12.
Row 17: P5, Cr3L, P8, Cr3R, P5.
Row 18: as row 10.
Row 19: P6, Cr3L, P6, Cr3R, P6.
Row 20: as row 8.
Row 2I: P7, Cr3L, P4, Cr3R, P7.
Row 22: as row 6.
Row 23: P8, Cr3L, P2, Cr3R, P8.
Row 24: as row 4.
Row 25: P9, Cr3L, Cr3R, P9.
Row 26: as row 2.
These 26 rows form cable panel and are repeated.

## BACK

Using 4.5 mm needles, cast on 48 , $52,58,62,68,72$ sts
Next row: (ws) KO (I, 0, 0, 3, 0), PI (2, 0, 2, 2, I), [K4, P2] $2(2,3,3$, $3,4)$ times, $K I 0$, inc once in each of next 2 sts, $\mathrm{KIO},[\mathrm{P} 2, \mathrm{~K} 4] 2(2,3,3$, $3,4)$ times, $\mathrm{PI}(2,0,2,2,1), \mathrm{KO}(\mathrm{I}$, $0,0,3,0) .50(54,60,64,70,74)$ sts. Now work in patt as follows:-
Row I: (rs) inc in first st, PO ( 0,3 , $0,2,0), \mathrm{KO}(0,0, I, 0,0),[\mathrm{Tw} 2] 0(\mathrm{I}$, $\mathrm{I}, 0, \mathrm{I}, 0)$ times, $[\mathrm{P} 4, \mathrm{Tw} 2] 2(2,2$, $3,3,4$ ) times, work next 24 sts as row I of cable panel, [Tw2, P4] 2 (2, $2,3,3,4)$ times, [Tw2] $0(I, I, 0, I$, 0 ) times, $K 0(0,0, I, 0,0), P O(0,3,0$, 2,0 ), inc in last st.
Row 2: inc in first st, $\mathrm{K} 0(1,0,0,3$, 0), PI (2, 0, 2, 2, I), [K4, P2] $2(2,3$, $3,3,4$ ) times, work next 24 sts as row 2 of cable panel, [P2, K4] 2 (2, $3,3,3,4)$ times, $\mathrm{PI}(2,0,2,2, I), \mathrm{KO}$ $(1,0,0,3,0)$, inc in last st. $54(58$, $64,68,74,78)$ sts. These 2 rows set the sts centre 24 sts worked as cable panel and sts either side worked in fancy rib patt. Cont as now set, inc I st at each end of next 7 rows, then on foll 5 alt rows, then on 2 foll 4 th rows, taking inc
sts into fancy rib patt. 82 (86, 92, 96, I02, I06) sts. Work 9 rows, ending with a ws row. Place markers at both ends of last row. Cast on 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows, taking these cast-on sts into fancy rib patt. 94 (98, 104, 108, II4, II8) sts. Cont straight until back measures
41 cm (16 in) from original caston edge, ending with a ws row.

## Shape raglan armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 88 (92,98, $102,108,1 \mid 2$ ) sts.
Next row: (rs) PI, P2tog, patt to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, PI.
Next row: KI, sl I, KI, psso, patt to last 3 sts, K2tog, KI.
Rep last 2 rows $2(2,4,4,6,7)$
times more. 76 (80, 78, 82, 80, 80) sts.
Next row: (rs) PI, P2tog, patt to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, PI.
Next row: K2, patt to last 2 sts,
K2. Rep last 2 rows 19 (20, 19, 20, 19, 19) times more, ending with a ws row. Break yarn and leave rem $36(38,38,40,40,40)$ sts on a holder.

## FRONT

Work as given for back until 52 $(54,54,58,58,58)$ sts rem in raglan armhole shaping. Work I row, ending with a ws row.

## Shape front neck

Next row: (rs) PI, P2tog, patt II (II, II, I3, I3, I3) sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. 13 ( $13,13,15,15,15$ ) sts. Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck. Keeping patt correct, dec I st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll $0(0,0, I, I, I)$ alt rows and at same time dec $I$ st at raglan armhole edge of 2 nd and foll $2(2,2,3,3,3)$ alt rows. 4 sts. Work I row, ending with a ws row. Next row: (rs) PI, P3tog. Next row: K2.
Next row: P2tog and fasten off.
Return to sts left on holder, slip centre $24(26,26,26,26,26)$ sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn with rs
facing, patt to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, PI. I3 (13, 13, I5, I5, I5) sts.
Keeping patt correct, dec I st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll $0(0,0, I, I, I)$ alt rows and at same time dec I st at raglan armhole edge of 2 nd and foll 2 (2, $2,3,3,3$ ) alt rows. 4 sts. Work I row, ending with a ws row.
Next row: (rs) P3tog tbl, PI.
Next row: K2.
Next row: P2tog and fasten off.

## SLEEVES

Using $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles, cast on 43(43, 45, 47, 47, 49) sts.
Row I: (rs) KI, *PI, KI, rep from * to end.

Row 2: PI, *KI, PI, rep from * to end. These 2 rows form rib. Work in rib for a further 9 rows, inc I st at end of last row and ending with a rs row. $44(44,46,48,48,50)$ sts. Change to $41 / 2 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles. Now work in fancy rib patt as follows:-
Row I: (ws) K3 (3, 0, 0, 0, 0), P2
(2, 0, I, I, 2), *K4, P2, rep from * to last $3(3,4,5,5,0)$ sts, $\mathrm{K} 3(3,4,4,4$, $0), P 0(0,0, I, I, 0)$.
Row 2: P3 (3, 0, 0, 0, 0), [Tw2]। (I, $0,0,0,0)$ times, $K 0(0,0, I, I, 2)$, *P4, Tw2, rep from * to last $3(3,4$, $5,5,6)$ sts, $\mathrm{P} 3(3,4,4,4,4), \mathrm{KO}(0,0$, I, I, 2).

These 2 rows form fancy rib patt. Cont in fancy rib patt, shaping sides by inc I st at each end of 4th and every foll 6th row to $54(62,62,64$, 72,72 ) sts, then on every foll 8th row until there are $68(70,72,74$, 76,78 ) sts, taking inc sts into fancy rib patt. Cont straight until sleeve measures $45(45,46,46,46,47)$ $\mathrm{cm}, 173 / 4(173 / 4,18,18,18,181 / 2) \mathrm{in}$, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. $62(64,66$, $68,70,72$ ) sts
Next row: (rs) PI,Tw2, PI, P2tog, patt to last 6 sts, P2tog tbl, PI,Tw2, PI

Next row: KI, P2, K2, patt to last 5 sts, K2, P2, KI. Rep last 2 rows I $9(20,21,22,23,24)$ times more,
ending with a ws row. 22 sts.

## Left sleeve only

Dec I st at each end of next row, then cast off 4 sts at beg of foll row. 16 sts. Dec I st at beg of next row, then cast off 5 sts at beg of foll row. 10 sts. Rep last 2 rows once more.

## Right sleeve only

Cast off 5 sts at beg and dec I st at end of next row. 16 sts. Work I row. Rep last 2 rows twice more.

## Both sleeves

Cast off rem 4 sts.

## NECKBAND

Join all raglan seams. With rs facing and using $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ circular needle, pick up and knit 16 sts from top of left sleeve, and $10(10,10,12,12$, 12) sts down left side of neck, patt across $24(26,26,26,26,26)$ sts on front holder dec 2 sts evenly, pick up and knit 10 (10, $10,12,12,12$ ) sts up right side of neck, and 16 sts from top of right sleeve, then patt across $36(38,38,40,40,40)$ sts on back holder dec 2 sts evenly across top of cable panel. 108 (II2, I I2, I I8, I I8, I I 8) sts. Next round: (rs) *KI, PI, rep from * to end. Rep last round 5 times more. Cast off in rib.

## HEM BORDERS (both alike)

With rs facing and using $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ circular needle, starting and ending at markers near cast-on sts, pick up and knit 9 sts down straight row-end edge to last inc, 30 sts down shaped row-end edge to cast-on edge, $49(53,59,63,69,73)$ sts from cast-on edge, 30 sts up shaped row-end edge to last inc, and 9 sts up straight row-end edge to marker. 127 (13I, I37, 141 , 147,151 ) sts.

Row I: (ws) KI, *PI, KI, rep from *to end.
Row 2: K2, *PI, KI, rep from * to last st, KI.
Rep last 2 rows twice more, then first of these rows again, ending with a ws row.
Cast off loosely in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew row-end edges of hem borders to cast-off sts near markers. Join side and sleeve seams, leaving side seams open for


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
