Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 19 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) over st st on 4.5mm needles.

If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

ROUND NECK SWEATER BACK

Using 3.75 mm needles, cast on 93 (103, 111, 121) sts

Ist row - KI,* PI, KI, rept from * to end.

2nd row - PI,* KI, PI, rept from * to end.

Rept the last 2 rows for 7.5 cm (3 ins) finishing on a 2nd row.
Change to 4.5mm needles.
Continue in st st until work measures 47 (48, 48, 49.5) cm 18.5 (19, 19, 19.5) ins from commencement, finishing on a P row for long version or 35.5 (37, 38, 39.5) cm 14 (14.5, 15, 15.5) ins for short version, finishing on a P row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Next row - K1, sl 1, K1, psso, K to last 3 sts, K.2tog, K1.

Work I row.

Dec I st at each end as before on the next and every following alt row until 35 (45, 47, 53) sts remain.

Next row - PI, P2tog, P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, PI.

Ist row - KI, sl I, KI, psso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, KI.

2nd row - PI, P2tog, P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, PI.

Rept 1st and 2nd rows 0 (2, 2, 3) times more.

SI remaining 29 (31, 33, 35) sts onto a st holder.

FRONT

Work exactly as instructions given for Back until 51 (57, 63, 67) sts remain, finishing on a P row.

Shape neck

Next row - K1, sl 1, K1, psso, K16 (18, 20, 21), turn.
Continue on the last set of sts as

follows:- ****

Dec I st at armhole edge as before on every following alt row **AT THE SAME TIME** dec I st at neck edge on the next 4 rows, then on every following alt row until 8 (10, 12, 13) sts remain. Keeping neck edge straight, dec I st at armhole edge as before on every following alt row until 5 (9, 9, 11) sts, then on every row until 2 sts remain.

K.2tog. Fasten off. ****
With right side facing, sl centre 13
(15, 17, 19) sts onto
a st holder, rejoin yarn to
remaining sts at neck edge.

Next row - K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Work as given for other side from **** to ****.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Using 3.75 mm needles, cast on 33 (37, 39, 43) sts.

Work 7.5 cm (3 ins) in rib as given for Back finishing on on a 1st row.

Next row (inc row) - Rib 6 (3, 4, 6), inc in next st, * rib 3 (5, 5, 5) inc in next st, rept from * to last 6 (3, 4, 6) sts, rib to end. 39 (43, 45, 49) sts.

Change to 4.5mm needles.
Continue in st st, inc I st at each end of 3rd and every following 4th row until 53 (53, 57, 61) sts, then on every following 6th row until 69 (73, 77, 81) sts are on the needle.

Continue without further inc until Sleeve measures 43 (45.5, 47, 48) cm 17 (18, 18.5, 19) ins from commencement, finishing on a P row.

Shape top

Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Work 0 (0, 0, 2) rows.

Next row - K1, sl 1, K1, psso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Work I row.

Dec I st at each end as before on the next and every following alt row until 9 (9, 7, 7) sts remain.

81/86 (91/97) cm 32/34 (36/38) inch sizes only

Next row - PI, P2tog, P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, PI. 7 sts.

All sizes

Work 0 (0, 1, 1) row. SI remaining sts onto a safety pin.

Neckband

Pin sleeves into position leaving left back raglan open.

Sew sleeves in.

With right side facing, using 3.75mm needles, K7 sts from left sleeve, pick up and K18 (18, 22, 22) sts down left side neck, K13 (15, 17, 19) sts from front neck st holder, pick up and K17 (17, 21, 21) sts up right side neck, K7 sts from right sleeve and 29 (31, 33, 35) sts from back neck st holder. 91 (95, 107, 111) sts.

Commencing on a 2nd row, work 4 cm (1.5 ins) in rib as given for Back. Cast off loosely in rib.

V NECK SWEATER

Work Back and Sleeves as instructions given for Round Neck Sweater.

FRONT

Work exactly as instructions given for Back to armholes, finishing on a P row.

Shape armhole and divide for front

Next row - Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts, K42 (46, 50, 54) including st on needle, dec I st, turn.

Continue on the last set of sts as follows:-

Work I row.

Next row - K1, sl 1, K1, psso, K to end.

Work I row.

**** Dec I st at armhole edge as before on the next and every following alt row **AT THE SAME**

TIME dec I st at front edge on every following 4th row from previous dec until 16 (II, I2, I3) sts remain.

81/86 cm (32/34) inch size only

Dec I st at armhole edge as before on every following alt row **AT**

THE SAMETIME dec 1 st at front edge on every following 6th row until 8 sts remain.

All sizes

Keeping front edge straight, dec I st at armhole edge as before on every following alt row until 5 (9, 9, 11) sts, then on every row untill 2 sts remain. K.2tog. Fasten off.

With right side facing, sl centre st onto a safety pin, rejoin yarn to remaining sts at neck edge.

Next row - Dec I st, K to end. Next row - Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts, P to end.

Next row - K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Work I row.

Work as instructions given for other side from **** to ****

Neckband

Pin sleeves into position leaving left back raglan open. Sew neckband in.

With right side facing, using 3.75mm needles, K7 sts from left sleeve, pick up and K57 (59, 65, 69) sts down left side neck, K st from safety pin (mark with a coloured thread), pick up and K58 (60, 66, 70) sts up right side neck, K7 sts from right sleeve, and 29 (31, 33, 35) sts from back neck st holder. 159 (165, 179, 189) sts.

Next row - PI,* KI, PI, rept from * to end.

Ist row - Rib to within 2 sts of marked st, K2tog tbl, K1, K2tog, rib to end.

2nd row - Rib to within 2 sts of marked st, P2tog, P1, P2tog tbl, rib to end

Rept, 1st and 2nd rows twice more, finishing on a 2nd row. Cast off in rib, dec as before.

MAKING UP

Join left back raglan and neckband. Join side and sleeve seams.

FINISHING

Block or press if desired.
