Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

#### IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Instructions given for 51 cm (20 inch) Chest, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is

given this applies to all sizes.

#### TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) over st st on 4mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

#### Special note

Smaller 3 sizes have two vertical bands of pattern on fronts, whilst larger 3 sizes have three vertical bands of pattern.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; P - Purl; st(s) - stitch(es); st st - stocking stitch (I row knit, I row purl); g st - garter stitch (every row knit); beg - beginning; alt - alternate; inc - increase; dec - decrease; patt - pattern; tog - together; tbl - through back of loops; sl I - slip one stitch; psso - pass slipped stitch over; yfwd - yarn forward; yon - yarn over needle; yfrn - yarn forward and round needle; cm - centimetres; ins - inches.

#### V NECK CARDIGAN BACK

Using 4mm needles, cast on 61 (67, 73, 79, 85, 91) sts. Work in g st for 10 rows, finishing on a wrong side row. Commencing with a K row, work in st st throughout as follows:-Continue straight until Back measures 17 (20, 24, 27, 30, 32) cm, 6.5 (7.75, 9.5, 10.5 11.75, 12.5) ins from beg, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Shape armholes

Cast off 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 49 (55, 61, 63, 69, 75) sts.

Continue without further shaping until armhole measures 12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 17) cm, 4.75(5, 5, 5, 6, 6, 25, 6.5) ins, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Shape shoulders

Cast off 4 (5, 6, 6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 5 (5, 5, 5, 7, 7) sts at beg of following 2 rows. Cast off remaining 23 (25, 27, 29, 31, 33) sts.

#### LEFT FRONT

Using 4mm needles, cast on 34 (37, 40, 43, 46, 49) sts. Work in g st for 10 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### **Commence patt**

**Ist row (right side)** - K8 (11, 14, 7, 10, 13), [P2, K3] 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) times, K6.

## **2nd row** - K6, [P3, K2] 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) times, P8 (11, 14, 7, 10, 13). **3rd row** - K8 (11, 14, 7, 10, 13), [P2, yon, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfrn, P2, K3] 2

(2, 2, 3, 3, 3) times, K6. **4th row** - As 2nd row.

These 4 rows form patt. Keeping patt correct throughout, continue as follows:-

Continue straight until Left Front matches Back to start of armhole shaping, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Shape armhole

Cast off 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts at beg of next row. 28 (31, 34, 35, 38, 41) sts. Work 1 row. \*\*\*

#### Shape front slope

**Next row (right side)** - Patt to last 7 sts, K2tog, K5.

\*\* Working all front slope decreases as set by last row, dec I st at front slope edge on 2nd and following 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5) alt rows, then on every following 4th row until 19 (21, 23, 23, 25, 27) sts remain.

Continue straight until Left Front matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, finishing at armhole edge.

#### Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 (5, 6, 6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next and following alt row, then 5 (5, 5, 5, 7, 7) sts at beg of following alt row.

Work in g st on remainig 6 sts for a further 5 (5.5, 6, 6.5, 7, 7.5) cm, 2 (2, 2.25, 2.5, 2.75, 3) ins, for back neck border extension. Cast off.

Mark position for button along front opening edge just below start of front slope shaping.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

Using 4mm needles, cast on 34 (37, 40, 43, 46, 49) sts. Work in g st for 10 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Commence patt

**Ist row (right side)** - K6, [K3, P2] 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) times, K8 (11, 14, 7, 10, 13).

**2nd row** - P8 (11, 14, 7, 10, 13), [K2, P3] 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) times, K6. **3rd row** - K6, [K3, P2, yon, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfrn, P2] 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) times, K8 (11, 14, 7, 10, 13).

4th row - As 2nd row

These 4 rows form patt.

Keeping patt correct throughout,

continue as follows:-Continue straight until Right Front matches Back I row below armhole shaping finishing on a wrong side row.

**Next row** (right side) - K2, K2tog, yfwd (to make a buttonhole), patt to end.

#### Shape armhole

Cast off 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts at beg of next row. 28 (31, 34, 35, 38, 41) sts.

#### Shape Front Slope

Next row (right side) - K5, K2tog tbl, patt to end. Complete as given for Left Front from \*\*, noting the bracketed exceptions.

#### **SLEEVES** (both alike)

Using 4mm needles, cast on 31 (33, 35, 37, 39, 41) sts. Work in g st for 10 rows, finishing on a wrong side row. Commencing with a K row, continue in st st throughout as follows:-Inc I st at each end of next and every following 4 (6, 6, 6, 6, 6)th

row until there are 45 (57, 59, 63, 65, 63) sts.

# I st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Inc I st at each end of every following 6 (8, 8, 8, 8)th row until there are 53 (61, 67, 71, 75) sts.

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#### All sizes

Continue without further shaping until Sleeve measures 20 (26, 30, 34, 38, 42) cm, 7.75 (10.25, 11.75, 13.25 15, 16.5) ins, from cast on edge, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### Shape top

Place markers at each end of last row to denote top of sleeve seam. Work a further 8 (8, 8, 10, 10, 10) rows. Cast off.

#### MAKING UP

Join shoulder seams. Join ends of back neck border extensions, then sew one edge to back neck. Matching centre of cast off edge of Sleeves to shoulder seams and markers to top of side seams, sew Sleeves to Back and Fronts Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on button.

#### FINISHING

Block or press if desired.
