This used approximately I .25 balls of the Sangria and around half a ball of the other shades. Totalling approx 4 Balls if you were to use a single colour

## IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Rep - Repeat; Rnd(s) - Round(s); SI st - Slip Stitch.

## BASKET

Note: Use a stitch marker to mark the start of the round. Chll.
Ist Row: Idc in 2nd ch from hook. Idc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. (IOdc)
2nd Row: ChI, Idc in each dc to end of row.Turn
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 10 " $(25.5 \mathrm{~cm})$

Beg working in rnds as follows. Ist Round: *Idc in each of next IOdc. Work 3dc in corner. Work IOdc evenly along side edge of bottom. Work 3 dc in corner. Rep from *around. (52dc) 2nd Round: Idc in each dc around.

Rep 2 nd rnd working 2 rows of each colour until you reach your 6th colour (2BI60 Petal Purple).

## Handle rows

Ist Round - Idc up until the place where you would like your handles to be. Ch4, skip 4dc and dc until the next handle location. Ch4, skip 4dc and dc until the end.
2nd Round - Idc in each dc around, including the 4 ch sts for each handle.
Fasten off.

## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the project.
4.5 dc and 3 rows $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$
