IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

For this project, as long as you cannot see gaps between your stitches then tension is not important. If you do have gaps then you can drop down to a smaller crochet hook. If your work is too tight then try going up to a bigger size of hook.

ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

Alt - Alternate; **Beg** - Beginning;
Ch - Chain(s); **Cont** - Continue;
Dc - Double Crochet;
Dc2tog - Double Crochet 2 together (In the next 2 sts draw up a loop, yoh and pull through all sts on hook); **Dec** - Decrease(ing);
Htr - Half Treble Crochet;
PM - Place Marker;
Rem - Remain(ing); **Rep** - Repeat;
Rnd(s) - Round(s); **Sl st** - Slip Stitch; **St(s)** - Stitch(es);
Tog - Together; **Tr** - Treble Crochet; **Yoh** - Yarn over hook.

SEAGULL AND DUCK Head

Note: Use a stitch marker to mark the start of the round.

Round 1 - With colour A, 10dc in a magic circle. (10dc)
Round 2 - 2dc in each st. (20dc)
Round 3 - 1dc in each st. (20dc)
Round 4 - 2dc in first st, 1dc in next st, *2dc in next st, 1dc in next st. Rep from * to end of round. (30dc)
Round 5 - Rep Round 3. (30dc)
Round 6 - 2dc in first st, 1dc in next 2 sts, *2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts. Rep from * to end of round. (40dc)
Rounds 7 - 12 - Rep Round 3. (40dc)
Round 13 - *Dc2tog, 1dc in next 2 sts. Rep from * to end of round. (30dc)
Round 14 - Rep Round 3. (30dc)
Round 15 - (Dec for neck) 1Dc in next 5sts, (Dc2tog) 10 times. Place stitch marker between 5th and 6th sc2tog's to mark centre front, 1dc in last 5 sts. (20dc)
Round 16 - 21 - Rep Round 3. (20dc)
Do not fasten off! Cont onto the

body.

Body

Round 1 - Ch28. 2dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1dc in each ch st to end of chain. (28dc worked in the ch).
1Dc in 20sts of neck.
Work into the foundation loop of the ch28, 1dc in each rem ch of next 26 ch, 2dc in last ch (in the last ch there will be a total of 4 dc). (76dc)
Round 2 - 1Dc in 37 sts, 2dc in next 2 sts, 1dc in 37 sts. (78dc)
Round 3 - 1Dc in each st. (78dc)
Round 4 - 1Dc in 38 sts, 2dc in next st, PM on last dc just worked to mark the front centre, 2dc in next st, 1dc in last 38 sts. (80dc)
Rounds 5 - 6 - Rep Round 3. (80dc).

Start the Tail Shaping.

Round 1 - Dc2tog, 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog. (78dc)
Round 2 - 1dc in each st. (78dc)
Round 3 - 4 - Rep Round 1. (74dc)
Round 5 - Rep Round 2. (74dc)

Start the Belly Shaping.

Round 1 - Dc2tog, 1dc in 33 sts, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc in 33 sts, dc2tog. (70dc)
Round 2 - 1dc in each st. (70dc)
Round 3 - Dc2tog, 1dc in 31 sts, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog. (66dc)
Round 4 - Rep Round 2. (66dc)
Round 5 - Dc2tog, 1dc in 29 sts, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog. (62dc)
Round 6 - Rep Round 2. (62dc)
Round 7 - Dc2tog, 1dc in 27 sts, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog. (58dc)
Round 8 - Rep Round 2. (58dc)
Round 9 - Dc2tog, 1dc in 25 sts, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog. (54dc)
Round 10 - Dc2tog, 1dc in 23 sts, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog. (50dc)
Round 11 - Rep Round 2. (50dc)
Fasten off leaving a long tail to close bottom.

Leg (Make 2)

Daffodil - Colour B

Steven - Colour C

Round 1 - Ch6 and sl st to join into a ring.

Rounds 2 - 10 - 1Dc in each st. (6dc)

Round 11 - (Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (9dc)

Round 12 - 1Dc in each st. (9dc)

Round 13 - (2dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (12dc)

Round 14 - (3dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (15dc)

Round 15 - Rep Round 12. (15dc)

Round 16 - (4dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (18dc)

Fold foot flat and line the sts up. St 1 to 18, St 2 to 17 etc. There should be 9 sts at the front and 9 at the back.

St 1 & 18 - Dc

St 2 & 17 - (Dc, Htr) in the same st.

St 3 & 16 - Dc

St 4 & 15 - (Htr, Tr) in the same st.

St 5 & 14 - (Tr, Htr) in the same st.

St 6 & 13 - Dc

St 7 & 12 - (Htr, Dc) in the same st.

St 8 & 11 - Dc

St 9 & 10 - Sl st

Fasten off, **do not stuff!**

Wing (Make 2)

Daffodil - Colour A

Steven - Colour B

Round 1 - 6dc in a magic circle. (6dc)

Round 2 - (Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (9dc)

Round 3 - 1Dc in each st. (9dc)

Round 4 - (2Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (12dc)

Round 5 - Rep Round 3. (12dc)

Round 6 - (3Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (15dc)

Round 7 - (4Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (18dc)

Round 8 - (5Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (21dc)

Rounds 9 - 10 - Rep Round 3. (21dc)

Round 11 - (6Dc, 2dc in next st) Rep to end of round. (24dc)

Rounds 12 - 13 - Rep Round 3.

(24dc)

Round 14 - 12dc, dc2tog, 10dc. (23dc)

Round 15 - 11dc, dc2tog, 10dc. (22dc)

Round 16 - 10dc, dc2tog, 10dc. (21dc)

Do not stuff!

Fold in half and sew across top.

Duck Beak

Round 1 - With Colour B Ch 6, 2dc in 2nd ch from hook, 3dc, 4dc in last ch st.

Now work along the other side of the foundation ch.

3dc, 2dc in last st. (14dc)

Round 2 - 2dc in first st, 2dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc, 2dc in next 2 sts, 2dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc, 2dc in last st. (20sts)

Rounds 3 - 5 - 1Dc in each st. (20sts)

Round 6 - Dc2tog, 6dc, (dc2tog) twice, 6dc, dc2tog in last 2 sts.

Fasten off leaving a length of yarn to sew beak onto head when required.

Do not stuff!

Seagull Beak

Round 1 - With Colour C, Ch 8 and sl st into first ch st.

Round 2 - 1Dc in each st. (8sts)

Round 3 - Dc2tog, 6dc (7sts)

Round 4 - Dc2tog, 2dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc. (7sts)

Round 5 - Dc2tog, 5dc. (6sts)

Round 6 - Dc2tog, 2dc, dc2tog. (4sts)

Round 7 - Dc2tog twice. (2sts)

Round 8 - Dc2tog. (1st)

Fasten off and stuff.

MAKING UP

Lightly stuff the head to give it a bit of shape so it makes placing your safety eyes and beak easier. Attach your safety eyes and finish stuffing the head, neck and body. Attach the beak. Finish stuffing the body. Sew up the underneath. Attach the wings to the side of the body and

then attach legs underneath.
