ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

Ch - Chain; **Sl st** - Slip Stitch;

Sp - Space; **St(s)** - Stitch(es); **Tr** - Treble.

BLANKET

Increasing

Row 1 - Ch5, 1tr in 3rd ch from hook, (This creates a sp to crochet into on the next row) 1tr in the next 2 ch sts.

This is called a shell.

Row 2 - Ch 5, 1tr in 3rd ch from hook, 1tr in the next 2 ch sts. Now flip your work so that you can now work in the space on the previous row from the 2 skipped ch sts.

Sl st into the sp created by the 2

skipped ch sts in the first shell, ch 2, 3tr into the same sp.

Row 3 - Ch 5, 1tr in 3rd ch from hook, 1tr in the next 2 ch sts, flip work, *Sl st into the sp created by the 2 skipped ch sts in the first shell, ch 2, 3tr into the same sp Repeat from * to the end of row.

Rows 4 - 48 - Repeat Row 3 with increases being made at both ends. Stop when you have 48 shell groups which should coincide with Row 48.

Sides

Note: You will now be decreasing and increasing at the same time. One side will start to decrease and the other will continue to increase.

On the decrease row, your last st should be a sl st into the beginning st from the previous row. This way your edge will be flat and not jagged.

Row 49 - Ch 1, turn, sl st into each of the next 3tr sts, *sl st around the ch2, ch2, 3tr into same sp. Repeat from * to the end of row ending with a sl st into the first st from the previous row.

Row 50 - Repeat row 3.

Rows 51 - 60 - All odd rows work as Row 49.

All even rows work as Row 50.

Decreasing

Row 61 to end - Ch 1, turn, sl st into each of the next 3tr sts, *sl st around the ch2, ch2, 3dc into same sp. Repeat from * to end of row ending with a sl st into the first st from the previous row.

Once you have 1 shell left fasten off and weave in any ends.

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
