Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the

garment.

24 sts and 32 rows to 10cm (4ins) over st st on 4mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size.

If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm - centimetres; **dec** - decrease;
g st – garter stitch (K every row);
inc - increase; **ins** – inches;
K - Knit; **P** – Purl; **st(s)** - stitch(es);
st st - stocking stitch (K 1 row, P 1 row).

HOODY BACK

Using A and 4mm needles, cast on 62 (68, 74, 80) sts and work 7 rows

in g st.

Join in B and commencing with a knit row (**changing colours after every 8th row**) continue in st st for a further 70 (82, 94, 106) rows, ending on a purl row. 77 (89, 101, 113) rows altogether.

Cast off 18 (20, 22, 24)sts, knit to end.

Cast off 18 (20, 22, 24)sts, purl to end.

Cast off remaining 26 (28, 30, 32) stitches.

RIGHT FRONT

Using A and 4mm needles, cast on 30 (33, 36, 39) sts and work 7 rows in g st.

Break off A.

Join in B and commencing with a knit row (changing colours after every 8th row) continue in st st for a further 58 (70, 82, 94) rows ending on a purl row. 65 (77, 89, 101) rows altogether.

Cast off 6 (7, 8, 9)sts, knit to end. 24, (26, 28, 30)sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on following 6 rows. 18 (20, 22, 24) sts

St st a further 7 rows. 79 (91, 103, 115) rows altogether.

Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

Using A and 4mm needles, cast on 30 (33, 36, 39) sts and work 7 rows in g st.

Break off A.

Join in B and commencing with a knit row (changing colours after every 8th row) continue in st st for a further 57 (69, 81, 93) rows ending on a knit row. 64, (76, 88, 100) rows altogether.

Cast off 6 (7, 8, 9)sts, purl to end. Knit 1 row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on following 6 rows. 18 (20, 22, 24)sts.

St st a further 7 rows 79 (91, 103, 115) rows altogether.

Cast off.

Sleeves (both alike)

Using 4mm needles and A, cast on 33 (37, 41, 45) sts and work 7 rows in garter stitch. Break off A.

Join in B and commencing with a

knit row (**changing colours after every 8th row**) continue in st st for 36 (46, 56, 66) rows, increasing 1 st at each end of every 4th (5th, 6th, 7th) row.
St st a further 4 rows 51 (55, 59, 63) sts.
Cast off.

Hood

Using A and 4mm needles, cast on 96 (98, 100, 102) sts and work 9 rows in g st.
Break off A. Beg with a K row work 8 rows in st st using B. (**Make sure you continue with colour changes after every 8th row.**)
Dec 1 st at each end of next and every following 3rd row 9 times. 76 (78, 80, 82)sts. Continue until you have worked 40 (42, 44, 46) rows.
Cast off.

MAKING UP

Sew shoulder seams Sew side and under arm seams. Fold hood in half and join back hood seam.

Button Border

Mark on your left or right fronts (boy or girl) where you would like to place buttons.
Using A and 4mm needles, cast on 6 sts and working in garter stitch continue until strip is long enough to go from the front hem up the front edge of the jacket.
Cast off. Once complete, stitch to your jacket edge.

Buttonhole Border

Make another border in the same way. Every time you reach a buttonhole marker work row as follows:
K2, yfwd, K2tog (to make a buttonhole), K2.
Continue in this manner until strip is long enough to go from the front hem up the front edge of the jacket.
Cast off. Once complete, stitch to your jacket edge.

Sew hood to jacket neck making sure to position the centre back of hood to centre of back, and front edges of hood to cast off edges of button and buttonhole border.

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
