Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.
Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

## IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.
24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm , (4ins) over st st on 3.75 mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm , then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

## ABBREVIATIONS

K - knit; P - purl; st(s) - stitch(es); st st - stocking stitch;
rept - repeat; beg - beginning;
tog - together; alt - alternate;
inc - increase(ing);
dec - decrease(ing); sl - slip;
psso - pass slipped stitch over.

## BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles and mc , cast on 100 (106, I I2, I I8, I24, I30, I36) sts and work 20 rows in KI, PI rib.
Change to 3.75 mm needles and work in st st (I row K, I row P), starting with a K row, until Back measures 38 cm (I5ins) from beg, ending with a P row.

## Shape Armholes

Cast off $7(6,6,5,4,3,3)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows.

## I st size only

Leave remaining 86 sts on a stitch holder.

2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th sizes only
Dec I st at both ends of next and every alt row until 90 (94, $98,104,108,1$ I2) sts remain, ending with a P row. Leave sts on a stitch holder.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25 mm needles and mc , cast on $50(52,56,58,62,64$,
68) sts and work 20 rows in KI,

PI rib, inc I st at end of last row on 2 nd, 4 th and 6 th sizes only. Change to 3.75 mm needles and work in st st, starting with a K row, until Front measures 36 (36, 37, $38,38,38,38) \mathrm{cms}$, 14.25 ( 14.25 , $14.5, \mathrm{I} 5, \mathrm{I} 5, \mathrm{I} 5, \mathrm{I} 5)$ ins from beg, ending with a P row.

## I st and 2nd sizes only Shape Yoke

Next row - K37 (40) sts, turn, sl I, $P$ to end.
Next row - K28 (34) sts, turn, sl I, $P$ to end.
Next row - KI9 (28) sts, turn, sl I, $P$ to end.

## Shape Armhole

Next row - Cast off 7 (6) sts,
K3 (16) (including st used in casting off), turn, sl I, P to end.

## 2nd size only

Next row - K2 tog, K8, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K2, turn, sl I, P to end.

## 3rd size only <br> Shape Yoke

Next row - K43 sts, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K37 sts, turn, sl I, P to end.

## Shape Armhole

Next row - Cast off 6 sts, K25
(including st used in casting off), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, Kı7, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, KIO, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K3, turn, sl I, P to end.

## 4th and 5th sizes only <br> Shape Armhole and Yoke

Next row - Cast off 5 (4) sts, K39
(43) (including st used in casting off), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K3I (35), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K24 (28), turn, sl $\mathrm{I}, \mathrm{P}$ to end.
Next row - K2 tog, KI7 (21), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, KIO (I5), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K3 (9), turn, sl $\mathrm{I}, \mathrm{P}$ to end.

## 5th size only

Next row - K2 tog, K3, turn, sl I, P to end.

## 6th size only

Shape Armhole
Next row - Cast off 3 sts, $K$ to end.
Next row - Purl.
7th size only
Shape Armhole
Next row - Cast off 3 sts, $K$ to end.
Next row - Purl.
Next row - K2 tog, K to end.
Next row - Purl.

## 6th and 7th sizes only

Shape Yoke
Next row - K2 tog, K45 (47), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K39 (40), turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K33, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K27, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K2 I, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, KI5, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K9, turn, sl I, P to end.
Next row - K2 tog, K3, turn, sl I, $P$ to end.

## All sizes

Leave remaining 43 ( $45,47,49$, $52,54,56)$ sts on a stitch holder.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work to match Left Front, reversing all shapings by reading P for K and K for P .

## SLEEVES

Using 3.25 mm needles and mc , cast on 50 ( $52,54,56,58,60$, 62) sts and work 24 rows in KI, PI rib.
Change to 3.75 mm needles and work in st st, starting with a K row and inc I st at both ends of 3rd and every following 6th row until there are $72(76,78,82,84$, 88,90 ) sts on the needle.Work straight until Sleeve measures 45.5 cm , ( 18 ins ) or desired length from beg, ending with a Prow.

## Shape Top

Cast off $7(6,6,5,4,3,3)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows.

## Ist size only

Leave remaining 58 sts on a stitch holder.

## 3rd, 4th and 7th sizes only

Work 2 rows straight.
2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th

## sizes only

Dec I st at both ends of next and every alt row until ( 60 , $62,64,64,66,68$ ) sts remain, ending with a $P$ row. Leave sts on a stitch holder.

## YOKE

IMPORTANT: When working fairisle, carry yarns loosely across back of work over not more than 3 sts at a time to retain elasticity of work but do not weave yarn in on every stitch; alternatively, we suggest that you use a separate length of yarn for each motif, twisting yarn when changing colours to avoid a hole.To facilitate working, the first section of the Yoke is worked on a circular needle in rows.

With right side of work facing, using 3.75 mm circular needle and mc, K across 43 (45, 47, 49, $52,54,56$ ) sts of Right Front, 58 $(60,62,64,64,66,68)$ sts of first Sleeve, 86 (90, 94, 98, 104, 108, II2) sts of Back, $58(60,62,64$, $64,66,68)$ sts of second Sleeve and $43(45,47,49,52,54,56)$ sts of Left Front. 288 (300, 312 , 324, 336, 348, 360) sts.
Dec row - Using mc, P8 (9, I0, I I, I2, I3, I4), P2 tog, [P25 (26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 ), P2 tog] IO times, $\mathrm{P} 8(9,10, I|, I 2, I 3| 4$,$) .$ 277, 289, 30I, 3I3, 325, 337, 349) sts.

Start fairisle, joining in colours as required.
Ist row $-K * 6 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 5 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, Imc.
2nd row - $\mathrm{P} * 5 \mathrm{mc}, 3 \mathrm{~A}, 4 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, Imc. 3rd row $-K * I B, 3 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{~A}, 1 \mathrm{mc}$, $2 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, IB.
4th row $-P * 2 B, 3 \mathrm{mc}, 3 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, $I B$, rept from * to last st, IB.
5th row $-K$ *Imc, $2 B, 3 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}$, $3 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{~B}$, rept from $*$ to last st, Imc.
6th row - As 4th row.
7th row $-K * I B, 4 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, I C$, $\mathrm{IA}, 4 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, IB.

8th row $-\mathrm{P} * 5 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, I C, I A$, 4 mc , rept from * to last st, Imc. 9th row - As 7th row.
IOth row - $P$ *Imc, $1 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{~A}$, $I C, 2 A, 2 \mathrm{mc}, I B$, rept from * to last st, Imc.
IIth row $-K * I B, 3 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{C}$, $\mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, IB.
I 2th row $-\mathrm{P} * 4 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{IA}$, 3 mc , rept from $*$ to last st, Imc. 13 th row $-K * 4 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{IA}$, 3 mc , rept from $*$ to last st, I mc . 14 th row $-P * 3 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{~A}$, 2 mc , rept from $*$ to last st, Imc. I5th row $-K * 3 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 5 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{IA}$, 2 mc , rept from * to last st, Imc. 1 6th row $-P * 3 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 5 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{IA}$, 2 mc , rept from * to last st, Imc. 17th row - As 15 th row.
18th row $-\mathrm{P} * 2 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{~A}, 5 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{~A}$, $I \mathrm{mc}$, rept from ${ }^{*}$ to last st, Imc . 19th row $-K * 2 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 7 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{IA}$, Imc, rept from * to last st, Imc. 20th row - $P * 2 \mathrm{mc}, I \mathrm{~A}, 7 \mathrm{C}, ~ I A$, Imc, rept from * to last st, Imc. 21 st row $-K * 2 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{C}$, I $\mathrm{mc}, 3 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{IA}, \mathrm{Imc}$, rept from * to last st, Imc.
22nd row - $P$ *Imc, 2A, 2C, $3 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{~A}$, rept from * to last st, Imc.
23rd row - K *Imc, IA, 2C, using mc, sl I, KI, psso, KI, K2 tog, K2C, IA, rept from * to last st, Imc. 23I (24I, 25I, 26I, 27I, 28I, 29I) sts.
24th row - P *2A, 2C, 3mc, 2C, IA, rept from * to last st, IA. 25th row $-K * I A, 2 C, 2 m c, I A$, $2 \mathrm{mc}, 2 \mathrm{C}$, rept from * to last st, 1 A .
26th row $-\mathrm{P} * \mathrm{I} \mathrm{A}, 2 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{Imc}, 3 \mathrm{~A}$, I mc, 2C, rept from * to last st, 1 A.
27th row $-\mathrm{K} * 2 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{mc}, 3 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{mc}$, IC, rept from * to last st, IC. 28th row $-\mathrm{P} * 2 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{Imc}, 5 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{Imc}$, IC, rept from * to last st, IC. 29th row $-\mathrm{K} * \mathrm{IC}, 2 \mathrm{mc}, 5 \mathrm{~A}$, 2 mc, rept from $*$ to last st, IC. 30th row - $\mathrm{P} * 3 \mathrm{mc}, 5 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, Imc.

3 lst row - $K * 3 \mathrm{mc}, 5 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, Imc.
32nd row - $\mathrm{P} * 4 \mathrm{mc}, 3 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from $*$ to last st, Imc.
33rd row - $\mathrm{K} * \mathrm{IC}$, 3mc, using A, sl I, K2 tog, psso, K3mc, rept from * to last st, IC. I85 (I93, 20I, 209, 217, 225, 233) sts
34th row - $\mathrm{P} * 2 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 2 \mathrm{mc}$, IC, rept from * to last st, IC.
35th row - $\mathrm{K} * 3 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{Imc}, \mathrm{IA}, \mathrm{Imc}$, 2C, rept from * to last st, IC.
36th row - As 34th row.
37th row - K *IC, $3 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}$, 3 mc , rept from * to last st, $I C$.
38th row - $\mathrm{P} * 4 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from ${ }^{*}$ to last st, Imc.
39th row $-K * 4 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, Imc. 40th row - $P$ *IB, $3 \mathrm{mc}, 1 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st $I B$.
41 st row $-K * 2 B, 2 m c, 1 A, 2 m c$, $I B$, rept from * to last st, IB.
42nd row - $P * 3 B, I \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{I} A$, Imc, 2B, rept from * to last st, IB.
43rd row - $K$ *2B, using mc , sl I, KI, psso, KIA, using mc, K2 tog, KIB, rept from * to last st, IB.
I39 (145, I5I, 157, 163, 169,
175) sts.

44th row - P *IB, $2 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 2 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from $*$ to last st, IB.
45th row $-K * \mid B, 2 \mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{IA}, 2 \mathrm{mc}$, rept from $*$ to last st, IB.
46th and 48th rows - As 44th row.
47th row - As 45th row.
49th row $-K$ *IB, using $\mathrm{mc}, \mathrm{K} 2$ tog, KIA, using mc, K2 tog, rept from * to last st, IB. 93 (97, IOI, 105, 109, 113,117 ) sts.
50th row - $P$ *IB, Imc, $I A, I \mathrm{mc}$, rept from * to last st, IB.

Break $A, B$ and $C$ and continue in mc only.
Next row - Knit.
Change to $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles.
Next row - KI, * PI, KI, rept
from * to end.
Next row - KI, *KI, PI, rept from

* to last 2 sts, K2.


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Rept last 2 rows 4 times more then cast off in rib.

## BUTTONHOLE BAND

Using 3.25 mm needles and mc , cast on 9 sts.
I st row - (Right side) KI, *KI, PI, rept from * to last 2 sts, K2.
2nd row - KI, *PI, KI, rept from * to end.

Rept these 2 rows 3 (I, 2, 3, I, 2, 3) times more.

Next row - Rib 3, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.
Next row - Rib, casting on over sts cast off in previous row.
Continue in rib working a further
7 buttonholes at intervals of 7 (7.5, 7.5, 7.5, 8.5, 8.5, 8.5) cm, 2.75 (3, 3, 3, 3.25, 3.25, 3.25)
ins, measured from base of previous buttonhole. Work 3 rows in rib after 8th buttonhole. Cast off in rib.

## BUTTON BAND

Work to match Buttonhole Band, omitting buttonholes.

## MAKING UP

Join side and sleeve seams, then set in sleeves.
Sew on Front Bands. Sew on buttons.
