ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

ch - chain; sl st - slip stitch;
sp - space; tr - treble; yoh - yarn
over hook;

Front Post Treble (fptr) - work-

ing around the post of the stitch instead of the 'v' of the stitch, yoh, from the front put hook under post, yoh, pull back through, yoh, pull through 2, yoh, pull through 2; **Back Post Treble (bptr)** - working around the post of the stitch instead of the 'v' of the stitch, yoh, from the back of your work, put hook under post, yoh, pull back through, yoh, pull through 2;

Puff Stitch - *yoh, hook through chain, pull yarn back through,**, repeat from * to ** four more times (11 loops on hook), yoh, pull through all 11 loops.

PATTERN NOTES

- •You will work rounds of granny stripes.
- •You will increase by two groups of

3tr every round.

- •It's worth checking that you have the same number of groups of 3tr between 2-ch point every now and then to ensure your poncho is symmetrical.
- •There is a suggested colour order to match the photo on the pattern front but you can use any colours and order you like. Total yarn quantities are specified in the size chart. Suggested colour order is: *A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H repeat from *

PONCHO

In Colour A start with a foundation chain the number of chains specified in the size chart.
SI st to the first chain to make a ring (be careful not to twist the chain when you do this).

TIP: In round 1 you will make x 2

ch spaces, you may like to mark each of these with a stitch marker to make them easier to identify for future rounds. You should have an equal number of groups of 3tr between the stitch markers.

Round I - In the same place as the sl st, make (ch3, 2tr, ch2, 3tr), skip 2 chains, *make 3tr in the next ch, , skip two chains**, repeat from * to ** 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times, in the next ch make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), repeat from * to ** 6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17) times, sl st to 3rd of 3-ch, fasten off.

TIP: In round 2 'Gap' refers to the space between two groups of 3tr.

Round 2 - Join new colour in the 2-ch point at the back of the poncho (below where you joined last round), in same sp make (ch3, 2tr, ch2, 3tr), make 3tr in every gap along to next 2-ch sp, in this sp make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), make 3tr in every gap along to end, sl st in 3rd of 3-ch, fasten off.







Repeat round 2 until poncho is desired length.

Suggested number of rounds: 0-6 months 10, 6-12 months 12, 1-2years 14, 2-4 years, 16, 4-6 years 18, 6-8 years 20, 8-10 years 22, 10-12 years 24, XS/S 24, M/L 26, XL/2XL 28, 3XL/4XL 30, 5XL/6XL 32

Weave in ends.

POM POM EDGING

Note: Photos at end to help Join new colour in the 2-ch sp at the back of the poncho, ch4, make a puff stitch in the second chain from the hook, ch2, sl st in same ch that you made the puff stitch in, ch2, sl st in the same 2-ch space, *ch4, make a puff stitch in the second chain from the hook, ch2, sl st in the same ch you made the puff stitch in, ch2, sl st in the next gap between groups of 3tr**, repeat from * to ** all the way along to next 2-ch gap, ch4, make a puff stitch in the second chain from the hook, ch2, sl st in same ch as you made the puff stitch in, ch2, sl st in same 2-ch sp, repeat from * to ** all the way around, sl st in the same place as you joined.

NECK EDGING



Round I - Join new colour in
the loop at back of neck where
you worked the (ch3, 2tr, ch2,
3tr) on round I, ch3, *make 2tr in
the next 2-ch sp, make Itr in the
loop where you worked the 3tr**
repeat from 8 to ** all the way
around, sls t to 3rd of 3-ch, do not
fasten off.

Round 2 - ch3,*make I fptr around next stitch, make I bptr around following stitch**, repeat from * to ** all the way around, sl st to 3rd of 3-ch

If you would like a deeper rib you can repeat round 2.
