## Ice Cream Garland

### Materials and Measurements

Ice Cream Size approx	
11.5	cm
4.5	ins
Yarnsmiths Pebble Haze and Pebble Haze Prints	
2.5mm Crochet Hook Yarn Needle	
Photographed using shades: 2C040 Marble, 2C080 Syenite, 2C090 Red Serpentine, 2C160 Chalcedony, 2C170 Fluorite, 2C200 Petalite, 2D100 Saltburn

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect item if any other brand is used. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

#### ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

**Beg** - beginning; **BLO** - back loop only; **Dc** - double crochet; **Inc** - increase; **MR** - Magic ring; **Rep** - repeat; **Rnd(s)** - round(s); **Dc** - double crochet; **Sk** - skip; **Sl st** - slip stitch; **St(s)** - stitch(es); **Tr** - treble; **{ }** - work a group of stitches all in the same stitch.

#### CONE (Make 6)

Using Syenite

**Round 1** - 8dc in MR.(8)

*Note: The following rnds are all made in BLO.*

**Round 2** - (dc, inc) rep 4 times (12)

**Round 3** - dc each st around (12)

**Round 4** - (dc, inc, sc) rep 4 times (16)

**Round 5** - dc each st around (16)

**Round 6** - (3dc, inc) rep 4 times

(20)

**Round 7** - dc each st around (20)

**Round 8** - (2dc, inc, 2dc) rep 4 times (24)

**Round 9** - dc each st around (24)

**Round 10** - (5dc, inc) rep 4 times (28)

**Round 11** - dc each st around (28)

**Round 12** - (3dc, inc, 3dc) rep 4 times (32)

**Round 13** - dc each st around (32)

**Round 14** - (7dc, inc) rep 4 times (36)

**Rounds 15-19** - dc each st around (36)

Fold cone flat. Working through both layers dc together (18)



Fasten off and weave in ends.



#### ICE CREAM SCOOP (Make 6)

Make 3 in Saltburn, 1 each in Chalcedony, Fluorite and Petalite.

**Round 1** - 6dc in MR (6)

**Round 2** - inc in each st (12)

**Round 3** - (dc, inc) rep 6 times (18)

**Round 4** - (2dc, inc) rep 6 times (24)

**Rounds 5-6** - dc each st around (24)

**Round 7** - (3dc, inc) rep 6 times

(30)

**Round 8** - (4dc, inc) rep 6 times

(36)

**Rounds 9-15** - dc each st around (36)

**Round 16** - 2sl st, (sl st, sk, {6tr}, sk) rep 4 times, 2sl st, (sl st, sk, {6tr}, sk) rep 4 times, sl st to beg sl st to join (8tr clusters)

Fasten off and leave a long tail.



#### CHERRY (Make 6)

Using Red Serpentine

**Round 1** - 8dc in MR (8)

**Round 2** - inc each st (16)

Sl st to beg sl st to join.

Fasten off and leave a long tail.

#### ASSEMBLY

You will use the long tails to sew everything together.

- Fold your ice cream scoop flat with the 3 sl st sections at each side, insert your cone so it is just inside of the ice cream scoop. Stitch together making sure to go through all layers.



- Sew a cherry on top of each scoop leaving the upper few stitches exposed.



- Arrange your ice creams so they alternate variegated and solid colour ice cream scoops.
- Using Marble ch 50, insert your hook through the top stitch of your first cherry and make a sl st, ch 30, join your next ice cream in the same way. Repeat until all ice creams are joined to the garland, finish off with another ch 50.



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
