Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; **P** - Purl; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **st st** - stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P); **alt** - alternate; **beg** - beginning; **inc** - increase; **dec** - decrease; **fol** - following; **rept** - repeat; **tog** - together; **sl** - slip; **psso** - pass slipped stitch over; **patt** - pattern; **yfwd** - yarn forward; **0** = no sts. or rows to be worked in that particular size; **cm** - centimetres; **ins** - inches.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 24 sts and 32 rows to 10cm (4ins) over st st on 4mm needles.

BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 43 (49, 55, 61, 67) sts.

1st Row (Right Side) - K1, * P1, K1, rept from * to end.

2nd Row - P1, *K1, P1, rept from * to end.

Rept. the last two rows for 4cm (1.5ins), finishing on a 2nd row. Change to 4mm needles.

Work in st st starting with a K row until work measures 10 (12, 14, 15, 17) cm, 4 (4.75, 5.5, 6, 6.75) ins from beg. finishing on a P row.

Shape Armholes

** Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Next Row - K.2tog, K1, yfwd, sl1, K1, psso, K to last 5 sts., K2tog., yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to end**

Rept. the last 2 rows until 29 (33, 31, 33, 39) sts remain. finishing on

a P row.

*****Next Row** - K2tog, K1, yfwd, K to last 3 sts, yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to end

Next Row - K2tog, K1, yfwd, sl1, K1, psso, K to last 5 sts. K2tog, yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to end***

Rept the last 4 rows until 21 (23, 23, 25, 27) sts remain.

Work 1 row.

Sl sts onto a st holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 27 (29, 33, 35, 39) sts and work 4cm (1.5ins) in rib as given for back, finishing on a 1st row.

Next Row - Rib and sl 7 sts onto a safety pin, rib to end, dec. 1 st at end for 1st, 3rd and 5th sizes only. 19 (22, 25, 28, 31) sts.

Change to 4mm needles.

Commence St St and Patt. Panel

1st Row (Right Side) - K6 (9, 12, 15, 18) yfwd, sl1, K1, psso, K3, yfwd, sl1, K1, psso, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K2.

2nd and Foll. Alt. Rows - P to end

3rd Row - K6 (9, 12, 15, 18), [yfwd, sl1, K1, psso., K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1] twice, K1.

5th Row - K6 (9, 12, 15, 18), yfwd, sl1, K1, psso, K2tog, yfwd., K3, yfwd, sl.1, K1, psso, K2tog, yfwd, K2.

6th Row - As 2nd Row

The last 6 rows form patt. Continue in patt. until work measures 10 (12, 14, 15, 17)cm, 4 (4.75, 5.5, 6, 6.75)ins from beg finishing on a wrong side row.

Shape Armhole

Keeping patt correct

Next Row - Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4, 5) sts patt to end.

Next Row - P to end

Next Row - K2tog, K1, yfwd, sl1, K1, psso, patt to end

Next Row - P to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows until 12 (14, 13, 14, 17) sts remain, finishing on a P row.

Next Row - K2tog, K1, yfwd, patt to end

Next Row - P to end.

Next Row - K2tog, K1, yfwd, sl1, K1, pss0, patt to end.

Next Row - P to end.

Rept. the last 4 rows 0 (1, 0, 0, 1) time more, then 1st to 3rd (1st to 3rd, 0, 0, 1st to 3rd) row again. 10 (11, 12, 13, 14) sts.

Work 0 (0, 1, 1, 0) rows.

Shape Neck

Next Row - Cast off 3 (4, 4, 4, 5) sts, P to end

Next Row - K2tog, K1, yfwd, [sl1, K1, pss0] 0 (0, 1, 1, 0) time, patt to end.

Next Row - P2tog, P to end

Next Row - K2tog, [K1, yfwd] 0 (0, 1, 1, 1) time, [sl1, K1, pss0] 0 (0, 0, 0, 1) time, patt 2 (2, 1, 2, 1) sts, K.2tog.

Next Row - P2tog, P to end

Next Row - [K2tog] 0 (0, 1, 1, 0) time, K3 (3, 2, 1, 3), [K2tog] 0(0, 0, 1, 1) time

Next Row - P3 (3, 3, 3, 4)

Next Row - [K2tog] 1 (1, 0, 0, 1) time, K1 (1, 3, 3, 2)

(41, 46, 51) cm (16, 18, 20) inch sizes only

Next Row - P3

Next Row - [K2tog] (1, 1, 0) time K (1, 1, 3)

(51) cm (20) inch size only

Next Row - P3

Next Row - K2tog, K1

All Sizes

Next Row - P2tog and fasten off

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3.75mm needles cast on 27 (29, 33, 35, 39) sts and work 2 rows rib as given for Back.

Next Row (Buttonhole row) - Rib 3, yfwd, K2tog, rib to end. Continue in rib until work measures 4 cm (1.5ins.) from beg finishing on a 1st row.

Next Row - [K2tog] 1 (0, 1, 0, 1) time, rib to last 7 sts, sl these 7 sts. onto a stitchholder, turn. 19 (22, 25, 28, 31) sts. Change to 4mm needles *****

Commence st.st. and patt.

Panel

1st Row (right Side) - K2, yfwd, sl1, K1, pss0, K3, yfwd, sl1, K1, pss0, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K to end

2nd and foll. alt. rows - P to end

3rd Row - K2 [yfwd, sl1, K1, pss0, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1] twice, K to end.

5th Row - K2, yfwd, sl1, K1, pss0, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl1, K1, pss0, K2tog, yfwd, K to end

6th Row - As 2nd row

The last 6 rows form patt.

Continue in patt. until work measures 10 (12, 14, 15, 17) cm 4 (4.75, 5.5, 6, 6.75) ins from beg, finishing on a right side row.

Shape Armhole

Keeping patt. correct.

Next Row - Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4, 5) sts, P to end

Next Row - Patt to last 5 sts, K2tog, yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to end

Rept. the last 2 rows until 12 (14, 13, 14, 17) sts remain, finishing on a wrong side row.

Next Row - Patt to last 3 sts, yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to end

Next Row - Patt to last 5 sts, K2tog, yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to end.

Rept. the last 4 rows 0 (1, 0, 0, 1) time more, then 1st to 4th (4th, 2nd, 2nd, 4th) row once more. 10 (11, 12, 13, 14) sts.

Shape Neck

Next Row - Cast off 3 (4, 4, 4, 5) sts, patt to last 3 (3, 5, 5, 3) sts, [K2tog] 0 (0, 1, 1, 0) time, yfwd, K1, K2tog.

Next Row - P to last 2 sts, P2tog.

Next Row - K2tog, K2 (2, 1, 2, 1) [K2tog] 0 (0, 1, 1, 1) time, [yfwd, K1] 0 (0, 1, 1, 1) time, K2tog.

Next Row - P to last 2 sts, P2tog

Next Row - [K2tog] 0 (0, 1, 1, 0) time, K3 (3, 2, 1, 3), [K2tog] 0 (0, 1, 1, 0) time.

Next Row - P3 (3, 3, 3, 4)

Next Row - K1 (1, 3, 3, 2), [K2tog] 1 (1, 0, 0, 1) time.

(41, 46, 51) cm. (16, 18, 20) inch sizes only

Next Row - P3.

Next Row - K (1, 1, 3), [K2tog] (1, 1, 0) time.

(51) cm. (20) inch size only

Next Row - P3

Next Row - K.1, K.2tog.

All Sizes

Next Row - P2tog and fasten off.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 27 (29, 31, 33, 35) sts and work 4cm. (1.5 ins) in rib as given for Back, finishing on a 2nd Row.

Change to 4mm needles and work in st st, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 4 (4, 5, 6, 6)th row to 37 (41, 43, 45, 49) sts. Continue without shaping until work measures 12.5 (14, 15, 16.5, 19) cm, 5 (5.5, 6, 6.5, 7.5)ins from beg, finishing on a P row.

Shape Top

Work as given for back from ** to **. Rept the last 2 rows to 15 (17, 19, 21, 25) sts. remain, finishing on a P row.

Work as given for back from *** to ***. Rept the last 4 rows until 11 sts remain.

Work 1 row.

Sl sts onto a stitch holder.

PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

MAKING UP

Join raglan seams by top sewing.

LEFT FRONT BAND

With right side of work facing and using 3.25mm needles rejoin yarn to inside edge, continue in rib until band is long enough when slightly stretched to fit up left front to neck shaping, finishing on a 2nd row.

Sl sts onto a stitch holder.

Break off yarn.

Sew band in position by top sewing. Mark positions for 4 (4, 5, 5,

5) buttons, the first to match button-hole already made and allowing for a 5(5, 6, 6, 6)th to be placed in neckband. Space remaining 3(3, 4, 4, 4) buttons evenly between.

RIGHT FRONT BAND

Work as given for left front band, making buttonholes to match markers on right side rows as before. (Do not break off yarn)

NECKBAND

With right side of work facing, sing 3.25mm needles rib across 7 sts from right front band, pick up and K10 (11, 13, 13, 15) sts up right side of neck, K. across 11 sts. of right sleeve top, 21 (23, 23, 25, 27) sts of back neck then 11 sts. of left sleeve top, pick up and K10 (11, 13 13, 15) sts down left side of neck then rib across 7 sts from left front border. 77 (81, 85, 87, 93) sts.

Work 5 rows in rib as given for back starting with a 2nd row and making a buttonhole as before on 2nd row.

Cast off in rib.

FINISHING

Join side and sleeve seams by top sewing. Sew on buttons.

For washing and pressing instructions see ball band.

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
