## ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; P - Purl; st(s) - stitch(es); st st - stocking stitch (I row K, I row P); alt - alternate;
beg - beginning; inc - increase;
dec - decrease; foll - following;
rept - repeat; tog - together;
sl - slip; psso - pass slipped stitch over; patt - pattern; yfwd - yarn forward; $\mathbf{0}=$ no sts. or rows to be worked in that particular size; $\mathbf{c m}$ centimetres; ins - inches.

## TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.
24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm (4ins) over st st on 4 mm needles.

## BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 43 $(49,55,61,67)$ sts.
I st Row (Right Side) - KI,* PI, KI, rept from * to end.
2nd Row - PI, *KI, PI, rept from * to end.

Rept. the last two rows for 4 cm (I.5ins), finishing on a 2 nd row. Change to 4 mm needles.
Work in st st starting with a K row until work measures 10 (12, I4,
$15,17) \mathrm{cm}, 4(4.75,5.5,6,6.75)$ ins from beg. finishing on a $P$ row.

## Shape Armholes

** Cast off $2(3,3,4,5)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows.
Next Row - K.2tog, KI, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K to last 5 sts., K2tog., yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - P to end**
Rept. the last 2 rows until 29 (33, $31,33,39$ ) sts remain. finishing on
a P row.
***Next Row - K2tog, KI, yfwd, K to last 3 sts, yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - P to end
Next Row - K2tog, KI, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K to last 5 sts. K2tog, yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - P to end***
Rept the last 4 rows until $21(23,23$, 25,27 ) sts remain.
Work I row.
SI sts onto a st holder.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 27 $(29,33,35,39)$ sts and work 4 cm (l.5ins) in rib as given for back, finishing on a Ist row.
Next Row - Rib and sl 7 sts onto a safety pin, rib to end, dec. I st at end for Ist, 3rd and 5th sizes only. I9 (22, 25, 28, 3I) sts.
Change to 4 mm needles.

## Commence St St and Patt. Panel

Ist Row (Right Side) - K6 (9, I2, I5, I8) yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K3, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K2.
2nd and Foll. Alt. Rows - $P$ to end
3rd Row - K6 (9, I2, I5, I8), [yfwd, sll, KI, psso., KI, K2tog, yfwd, KI] twice, KI.
5th Row - K6 (9, I2, I5, I8), yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K2tog, yfwd., K3, yfwd, sl. I, KI, psso, K2tog, yfwd, K2.
6th Row - As 2nd Row
The last 6 rows form patt. Continue in patt. until work measures $10(12,14, I 5,17) \mathrm{cm}, 4(4.75,5.5$, $6,6.75$ )ins from beg finishing on a wrong side row.

## Shape Armhole

Keeping patt correct
Next Row - Cast off $2(3,3,4,5)$
sts patt to end.
Next Row - P to end
Next Row - K2tog, KI, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, patt to end
Next Row - P to end.
Rept. the last 2 rows until 12 (14, $13,14,17$ ) sts remain, finishing on a $P$ row.
Next Row - K2tog, KI, yfwd, patt to end

Next Row - P to end.
Next Row - K2tog, KI, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, patt to end.
Next Row - P to end.
Rept. the last 4 rows $0(1,0,0, I)$
time more, then Ist to 3 rd (Ist to 3rd, 0, 0, Ist to 3rd) row again. 10 (II, I2, I3, I4) sts.
Work $0(0, I, I, 0)$ rows.

## Shape Neck

Next Row - Cast off 3 (4, 4, 4, 5) sts, $P$ to end
Next Row - K2tog, KI, yfwd, [sII, KI, psso] $0(0, I, I, 0)$ time, patt to end.
Next Row - P2tog, P to end
Next Row - K2tog, [KI, yfwd] 0
( $0, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}$ ) time, [sII, KI, psso] 0 ( 0 , $0,0, \mathrm{I})$ time, patt $2(2, \mathrm{I}, 2, \mathrm{I})$ sts, K.2tog.

Next Row - P2tog, P to end
Next Row - $[\mathrm{K} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 0$ ( $0, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}, 0$ ) time, K3 (3, 2, I, 3), [K2tog] 0(0, 0, I, I) time
Next Row - P3 (3, 3, 3, 4)
Next Row - [K2tog] I (I, 0, 0, I)
time, $\mathrm{KI}(\mathrm{I}, 3,3,2)$
$(41,46,5 I) \mathrm{cm}(16,18,20)$ inch sizes only
Next Row - P3
Next Row - [K2tog] (I, I, 0) time K (I, I, 3)
(5 I) cm (20) inch size only Next Row - P3
Next Row - K2tog, KI

## All Sizes

Next Row - P2tog and fasten off

## RIGHT FRONT

Using 3.75 mm needles cast on 27 $(29,33,35,39)$ sts and work 2 rows rib as given for Back.
Next Row (Buttonhole row) - Rib
3 , yfwd, K2tog, rib to end. Continue in rib until work measures 4 cm (I.5ins.) from beg finishing on a Ist row.
Next Row - [K2tog] I ( $0, \mathrm{I}, 0, \mathrm{I}$ ) time, rib to last 7 sts, sl these 7 sts. onto a stitchholder, turn. 19 $(22,25,28,3 \mathrm{I})$ sts. Change to 4 mm needles ******

Commence st.st. and patt. Panel
Ist Row (right Side) - K2, yfwd,
sII, KI, psso, K3, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K to end
2nd and foll. alt. rows - P to end
3rd Row - K2 [yfwd, slI, KI, psso., KI, K2tog, yfwd, KI] twice, K to end.
5th Row - K2, yfwd, slI, KI, psso, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sll, KI, psso, K2tog, yfwd, K to end
6th Row - As 2nd row
The last 6 rows form patt.
Continue in patt. until work
measures $10(12,14,15,17) \mathrm{cm}$
4 (4.75, 5.5, 6, 6.75) ins from beg,
finishing on a right side row.

## Shape Armhole

Keeping patt. correct.
Next Row - Cast off $2(3,3,4,5)$ sts, $P$ to end
Next Row - Patt to last 5 sts, K2tog, yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - $P$ to end
Rept. the last 2 rows until 12 (14, $13,14,17$ ) sts remain, finishing on a wrong side row.
Next Row - Patt to last 3 sts, yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - $P$ to end
Next Row - Patt to last 5 sts, K2tog, yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - P to end.
Rept. the last 4 rows $0(1,0,0,1)$ time more, then Ist to 4th (4th, 2nd, 2nd, 4th) row once more. 10 (II, I2, I3, I4) sts.

## Shape Neck

Next Row - Cast off 3 (4, 4, 4,
5) sts, patt to last $3(3,5,5,3)$ sts,
[K2tog] $0(0, I, I, 0)$ time, yfwd, KI, K2tog.
Next Row - P to last 2 sts, P2tog.
Next Row - K2tog, K2 (2, I, 2, I)
[K2tog] 0, ( $0, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}$ ) time, [yfwd,
$\mathrm{KI}] 0(0, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I})$ time, K2tog.
Next Row - P to last 2 sts, P2tog
Next Row - $[\mathrm{K} 2 \operatorname{tog}] 0$ ( $0, \mathrm{I}, \mathrm{I}, 0$ )
time, K3 (3, 2, I, 3), [K2tog] 0 ( 0,1 , I, 0) time.
Next Row - P3 (3, 3, 3, 4)
Next Row - KI (I, 3, 3, 2),
[K2tog] I (I, 0, 0, I) time.
(4I, 46, 51 ) cm. ( $16,18,20$ ) inch sizes only
Next Row - P3.
Next Row - K (I, I, 3), [K2tog] $(1, I, 0)$ time.
(5 I) cm. (20) inch size only
Next Row - P. 3
Next Row - K.I, K.2tog.

## All Sizes

Next Row - P2tog and fasten off.

## SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 3.25 mm needles, cast on 27 ( $29,3 \mathrm{I}, 33,35$ ) sts and work 4 cm . ( 1.5 ins) in rib as given for Back, finishing on a 2nd Row.
Change to 4 mm needles and work in st st, inc I st at each end of 3rd and every foll $4(4,5,6,6)$ th row to $37(4 \mathrm{I}, 43,45,49)$ sts. Continue without shaping until work measures $12.5(14,15,16.5,19) \mathrm{cm}$, 5 ( $5.5,6,6.5,7.5$ )ins from beg, finishing on a $P$ row.

## Shape Top

Work as given for back from ** to
**. Rept the last 2 rows to 15 (I7, $19,21,25$ ) sts. remain, finishing on a P row.
Work as given for back from *** to
***. Rept the last 4 rows until II
sts remain.
Work I row.
SI sts onto a stitch holder.

## PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

## MAKING UP

Join raglan seams by top sewing.

## LEFT FRONT BAND

With right side of work facing and using 3.25 mm needles rejoin yarn to inside edge, continue in rib until band is long enough when slightly stretched to fit up left front to neck shaping, finishing on a 2nd row.
SI sts onto a stitch holder.
Break off yarn.
Sew band in position by top
sewing. Mark positions for $4(4,5,5$,
5) buttons, the first to match button-hole already made and allowing for a $5(5,6,6,6)$ th to be placed in neckband. Space remaining $3(3,4,4,4)$ buttons evenly between.

## RIGHT FRONT BAND

Work as given for left front band, making buttonholes to match markers on right side rows as before. (Do not break off yarn)

## NECKBAND

With right side of work facing, sing 3.25 mm needles rib across 7 sts from right front band, pick up and KIO (II, I3, I3, I5) sts up right side of neck, K. across II sts. of right sleeve top, $21(23,23$, 25,27 ) sts of back neck then II sts. of left sleeve top, pick up and KIO (II, I3 I3, I5) sts down left side of neck then rib across 7 sts from left front border. 77 (81, 85, 87, 93) sts.
Work 5 rows in rib as given for back starting with a 2nd row and making a buttonhole as before on 2nd row.
Cast off in rib.

## FINISHING

Join side and sleeve seams by top sewing. Sew on buttons.

For washing and pressing instructions see ball band.

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
