ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

Dc - Double crochet;
Dec - Decrease; **Inc** - Increase;
MR - Magic ring.

WATERMELON Body

Note: Use a stitch marker to mark the start of the round.

Working in colour A.

Chain 15.

Round 1 - Dc in the 2nd chain from the hook and in the next 12 chains. 3dc into the final chain.

Now working up the other side of the foundation chain, dc into the next 12 chains, 3dc into the final chain (31)

Round 2 - Inc, 12dc, inc, dc, inc, 13dc, inc, dc (35)

Round 3 - Inc, dc, inc, 11dc, (dc, inc) 3 times, 11dc, (dc, inc) 2 times (42)

Rounds 4 - 6 - Dc around for 3 rounds (42)

Round 7 - (5dc, dec) 6 times around (36)

On the last stitch of Round 7, change to colour B. You can cut and fasten off colour A here.

Rounds 8 - 9 - Dc around for 2 rounds (36)

On the last stitch of Round 9, change to colour C. You can cut and fasten off colour B here.

Round 10 - (2dc, dec, 2dc) 6 times around (30)

Rounds 11 - 12 - Dc around for 2 rounds (30)

Round 13 - (3dc, dec) 6 times around (24)

Rounds 14 - 15 - Dc around for 2 rounds (24)

Start to stuff and continue to stuff as you go. Finish your stuffing after round 18.

Round 16 - (Dc, dec, dc) 6 times around (18)

Round 17 - Dc around (18)

Round 18 - (Dc, dec) 6 times around (12)

Round 19 - Dec around (6)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail of yarn. Weave your tail through the front loops only of the remaining 6 stitches and pull it tightly to close. Weave in any ends.



EMBROIDERY - Watermelon Seeds

Using a long strand of colour E, embroider vertical seeds at random points on the colour C section of the body. Each seed is one stitch in length.



EMBROIDERY - Eyes and Mouth

Starting with colour E, embroider two layers from the top of Round 9 to the bottom of Round 8. Embroider these layers 5 visible stitches apart.

Using a strand of the White DK, embroider one layer in between the two layers of the black embroidery. To do this, your needle and yarn needs to come out at the middle of Round 9. Loop the yarn around the black yarn (on the inside of the eye) strand and re-enter your needle into the same place where it initially exited.

Repeat this process with another strand of the White DK, this time from the bottom of Round 9 and wrapping around the other (outside of the eye) strand.

Finally using a strand of Black DK, embroider a smile in between each eye.



Legs (Make 2)

Working in colour D.

Round 1 - 6dc into a MR (6)

Round 2 - Inc into each stitch around (12)

Round 3 - Dc around in the back loops only (12)

Round 4 - Dc around (12)

Round 5 - 3dc, 3dec, 3dc (9)

Round 6 - Dc, 3dec, 2dc (6)

Lightly stuff the bottom of the foot. Do not stuff the remainder of the leg.

Rounds 7 - 8 - Dc around for 2 rounds (6)

Round 9 - Fold the leg in half and 3dc across the top to close the hole. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the legs to Round 2 of the body, one visible stitch apart.
