






TIPS & TECHNIQUES

MAGIC RING DIAGRAM

A magic ring is made and worked into to prevent a hole being present in the middle of the work. By pulling the tail it tightens up the ring to create a centre with no hole.

Lay the tail end of yarn down across the left hand so the tail is pointing downwards. Take the working end of the yarn and wrap it around the thumb clockwise so that where the yarn crosses is facing you. Lay the working end down the back of the hand.



Take the hook and insert it under the tail end, grab the yarn and pull under the tail end to form a loop around the hook.




Yarn over with the working end of yarn and make 1 ch.

Keeping the ring in place slip the ring off the thumb and hold the hook and yarn as you would to work your crochet. Insert the hook into the ring and work as many dc's as needed into the ring. Whilst holding onto the work pull the tail gently to close up the ring. This will now count as your 1st round.

CARDIGAN

BACK

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on **85** [89:93:95:99] sts.
1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.
2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.
1st and 2nd rows set 1x1 rib.
Work 5 rows more in 1x1 rib.
8th Row. P3 [4:6:7:3], p2tog, (p5 [4:4:4:4], p2tog) 11 [13:13:13:15] times, p3 [5:7:8:4]. **73** [75:79:81:83] sts.
Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-
1st Row. K2 [3:1:2:3], p1, * k3, p1, rep from * to last **2** [3:1:2:3] sts, k2 [3:1:2:3].
2nd and Every Alt Row. Purl.
3rd Row. Knit.
5th Row. K0 [1:3:0:1], p1, * k3, p1, rep from * to last **0** [1:3:0:1] sts, k0 [1:3:0:1].
7th Row. Knit.
8th Row. Purl.
From 1st to 8th row sets patt. **
Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until back measures **37** [39:41:43:45]cm, (14½ [15½:16:17:17¾]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SHOULDERS

Cast off **11** [12:13:13:14] sts in patt at beg of next 2 rows. **51** [51:53:55:55] sts.
Cast off **12** [12:13:14:14] sts in patt at beg of next 2 rows. 27 sts.
Cast off rem 27 sts in patt.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on **38** [40:42:44:46] sts.
1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to end.
1st row sets rib.
Work 6 rows more in rib.
8th Row. P2 [1:2:3:1], p2tog, (p6 [5:5:4:4], p2tog) 4 [5:5:6:7] times, p2 [2:3:3:1]. **33** [34:36:37:38] sts.
Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-
1st Row. K2 [3:1:2:3], p1, * k3, p1, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.
2nd and Every Alt Row. Purl.
3rd Row. Knit.
5th Row. K0 [1:3:0:1], p1, * k3, p1, rep from * to end.
7th Row. Knit.
8th Row. Purl.
From 1st to 8th row sets patt.
Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until left front measures **21** [23:25:27:28]cm, (8¼ [9:9¾:10¾:11]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE NECK

1st Row. Patt to last 2 sts, patt2tog (neck edge). **32** [33:35:36:37] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2nd rows set neck shaping.
Work 33 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row. **23** [24:26:27:28] sts.
Cont without shaping until left front measures **37** [39:41:43:45]cm, (14½ [15½:16:17:17¾]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Next Row. Cast off **11** [12:13:13:14] sts in patt, patt to end. **12** [12:13:14:14] sts.
Next Row. Purl.
Cast off rem **12** [12:13:14:14] sts in patt.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on **38** [40:42:44:46] sts.
1st Row. * P1, k1, rep from * to end.
1st row sets rib.
Work 6 rows more in rib.
8th Row. P2 [2:3:3:1], p2tog, (p6 [5:5:4:4], p2tog) 4 [5:5:6:7] times, p2 [1:2:3:1]. **33** [34:36:37:38] sts.
Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-
1st Row. K2, p1, * k3, p1, rep from * to last **2** [3:1:2:3] sts, k2 [3:1:2:3].
2nd and Every Alt Row. Purl.
3rd Row. Knit.

5th Row. P1, * k3, p1, rep from * to last **0** [1:3:0:1] sts, k0 [1:3:0:1].

7th Row. Knit.

8th Row. Purl.

From 1st to 8th row sets patt.

Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until right front measures **21** [23:25:27:28]cm, (8¼ [9:9¾:10¾:11]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE NECK

1st Row. Patt2tog (neck edge), patt to end. **32** [33:35:36:37] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2nd rows set neck shaping.
Work 33 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row. **23** [24:26:27:28] sts.
Cont without shaping until right front measures **37** [39:41:43:45]cm, (14½ [15½:16:17:17¾]in), ending with a rs row.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Next Row. Cast off **11** [12:13:13:14] sts, purl to end. **12** [12:13:14:14] sts.
Next Row. Patt.
Cast off rem **12** [12:13:14:14] sts.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on **41** [41:45:45:45] sts, work 7 rows in 1x1 rib.
8th Row. P2 [2:4:4:4], p2tog, (p5 [5:3:3:3], p2tog) 5 [5:7:7:7] times, p2 [2:4:4:4]. **35** [35:37:37:37] sts.
Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2nd rows set st-st (stocking stitch).
Working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 4th row to **55** [49:57:51:53] sts.
Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 6th row to **61** [61:67:67:69] sts.
Cont without shaping until sleeve measures **28** [30:32:34:36]cm, (11 [11¾:12½:13½:14]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SLEEVE TOP

Cast off **6** [6:7:7:7] sts at beg of next **4** [4:6:6:6] rows. **37** [37:25:25:27] sts.
Cast off **7** [7:8:8:8] sts at beg of next **4** [4:2:2:2] rows. **9** [9:9:9:11] sts.
Cast off rem **9** [9:9:9:11] sts.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and A, starting at lower edge of right front, pick up and knit 5 sts evenly along rib, **50** [54:60:66:68] sts evenly along straight edge, **44** [44:44:44:46] sts evenly along shaped edge and 16 sts evenly to centre back of neck.
115 [119:125:131:135] sts.

Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 7 rows.

Cast off in rib.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and A, starting at centre back of neck, pick up and knit 16 sts evenly from back of neck, **44** [44:44:44:46] sts evenly along shaped edge, **50** [54:60:66:68] sts evenly along straight edge and 5 sts evenly along rib. **115** [119:125:131:135] sts.

Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 7 rows.

Cast off in rib.

POCKETS (Make 2)

STRAWBERRY CROCHET OPTION

NB These instructions use **UK** crochet terms throughout - **US** terms are given in brackets in the abbreviations section where applicable

Please note 1 ch at the beginning of each row does not count as a stitch throughout.

Using 4.00 hook and B, make a magic loop, 1ch, 3dc into the magic loop, turn.

2nd Row. 1ch (1ch does not count as a st), 2dc into 1st st, 1dc in next st, 2dc in last st, turn. 5dc.

3rd Row. 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, turn.

4th Row. 1ch, 2dc into 1st st, 1dc in each dc to last st, 2dc in last st, turn. 7dc.

5th Row. 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, turn.

Rep 4th and 5th rows 6 times more. 19dc.

18th Row. 1dc in 1st st, miss next st, 1dc in each st until last 2 sts, miss next st, 1dc into last st, 1ch, turn. 17dc.

19th Row. 1dc into each st to end, 1ch, turn.

Rep 18th and 19th rows twice more. 13dc.

24th Row. 1dc into each st to end.

Pull yarn through to finish and weave in all ends.

STRAWBERRY LEAVES (Make 2)

Using 4.00 hook and C, make 15ch.

1st Row. 1dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1dc into each st to end, turn. 14dc.

2nd Row. 1ch, 1dc into each dc to end, turn. 14dc.

3rd Row. 1ch, 1dc into each dc to end, turn.

4th Row. Slip st into 1st dc, 1dc into next dc, 1htr into next dc, 3tr into next dc, 1htr into next dc, 1tr into next dc, 2dtr into next dc, 2dtr into next dc, 1tr into next dc, 1htr into next dc, 3tr into next dc, 1htr into next dc, 1dc into next dc, slip st into last dc. Pull yarn through to finish and weave in all ends.

TO COMPLETE

Sew leaves to the top of the strawberry and using D, randomly embroider French knots for the strawberry seeds.

POCKETS (MAKE 2)

STRAWBERRY KNITTED OPTION

Using 4mm needles and B, cast on 5 sts.

1st Row. (K1, p1) twice, k1.

2nd Row. As 1st row.

3rd Row. K1, m1, p1, k1, p1, m1, k1. 7 sts.

4th Row. (P1, k1) 3 times, p1.

5th Row. K1, m1p, (k1, p1) twice, k1, m1p, k1. 9 sts.

6th Row. P1, (p1, k1) 3 times, p2.

7th Row. K1, m1, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1, m1, k1. 11 sts.

8th Row. (P1, k1) 5 times, p1.

9th Row. K1, m1p, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1, m1p, k1. 13 sts.

10th Row. P1, (p1, k1) 5 times, p2.

11th Row. K1, m1, (p1, k1) 5 times, p1, m1, k1. 15 sts.

12th Row. (P1, k1) 7 times, p1.

13th Row. K1, (k1, p1) 6 times, k2.

14th Row. (P1, k1) 7 times, p1.

15th Row. K1, m1p, (k1, p1) 6 times, k1, m1p, k1. 17 sts.

16th Row. P1, (p1, k1) 7 times, p2.

17th Row. K1, m1, (p1, k1) 7 times, p1, m1, k1. 19 sts.

18th Row. (P1, k1) 9 times, p1.

19th Row. K1, (k1, p1) 8 times, k2.

20th Row. (P1, k1) 9 times, p1.

21st Row. K1, m1p, (k1, p1) 8 times, k1, m1p, k1. 21 sts.

22nd Row. P1, (p1, k1) 9 times, p2.

23rd Row. K1, m1, (p1, k1) 9 times, p1, m1, k1. 23 sts.

24th Row. (P1, k1) 11 times, p1.

25th Row. K1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k2.

26th Row. (P1, k1) 11 times, p1.

27th Row. K1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k2.

28th Row. (P1, k1) 11 times, p1.

29th Row. S1, k1, pss0, (p1, k1) 9 times, p1, k2tog. 21 sts.

30th Row. P1, (p1, k1) 9 times, p2.

31st Row. S1, k1, pss0, (k1, p1) 8 times, k1, k2tog. 19 sts.

32nd Row. (P1, k1) 9 times, p1.

33rd Row. S1, k1, pss0, (p1, k1) 7 times, p1, k2tog. 17 sts.

34th Row. P1, (p1, k1) 7 times, p2.

35th Row. S1, k1, pss0, (k1, p1) 6 times, k1, k2tog. 15 sts.

36th Row. (P1, k1) 7 times, p1.

Cast off rem 15 sts in patt.

Strawberry Leaves (Make 2)

Using 4mm needles and C, cast on 15 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Next Row. * K1, m1, rep from * to last st, k1. 29 sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. Purl.

Knit 2 rows.

Cast off.

TO COMPLETE

Sew cast on edge of the leaves to the top of the strawberry and using D, randomly embroider French knots for the strawberry seeds.

TO MAKE UP

Join seam at centre back of neck. Fold sleeves in half lengthways then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position for approximately **16** [16:17:17:18]cm, (**6¼** [6¼:6½:6½:7]in) from top of shoulder. Join side and sleeve seams. Place pockets evenly 4 to 5cm (1½ to 2in) up from cast on edge on fronts of garment and sew in position as shown in photograph. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
